WHEREAS, Ernest P. Masullo served as Police Chief until his retirement in December 2016 after 40 years, having served a population of 16,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, Ernest P. Masullo worked to modernize the 29-officer force, including enhancing training programs, participating in drug prevention programs, upgrading technology, and providing new equipment for officers; and

WHEREAS, Ernest P. Masullo primary goal was serving the community both personally and professionally including volunteering as a fireman and EMT with the Angola Fire Department from 1973 to 1980, serving in youth baseball, football and wrestling, helping senior citizens and people with disabilities, working with animal rescue organizations, and serving as a Lake Shore Central School board Member from 1992-1997.
