I HEREBY CERTIFY, That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 27th day of April, 2017, A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Erie County residents demonstrate their spirit of compassion through the donation of organs, tissues, stem cells, and blood; and

WHEREAS, April has been declared "Donate Life Month" throughout the nation and resolutions have been passed in counties throughout New York encouraging residents to participate in organ donation; and

WHEREAS, each individual donor has the potential to save up to 8 lives through organ donation and improve 75 lives through tissue donation; and

WHEREAS, nationwide there are over 118,000 people waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant; and

WHEREAS, across Western New York there is a severe shortage of organ donors with over 10,000 New Yorkers on the waiting list, and during Donate Life Month, officials aim to educate the public about donating; and

WHEREAS, New York State has the 41st lowest participation rate in organ donation, a statistic that needs to be changed thus saving lives; and

WHEREAS, during the month of April, all Erie County Auto Bureau locations offer convenient opportunities to register as a donor, to help increase the state's donor rate.

RESOLVED, the Erie County Legislature pauses in its deliberations to proclaim April 2017 as Donate Life Month in Erie County.
