WHEREAS, Logan Paul Gunderman is the son of John & Lani Gunderman and is a freshman at Hamburg High School, and;

WHEREAS, Logan Paul Gunderman is the goalie for Hamburg High School, Champions, Buffalo Lacrosse Academy, Bison as well as Junior Buffalo Bandits, and;

WHEREAS, Logan Paul Gunderman has volunteered for the Friends of the Night People and St. Brigid's Food Pantry and Outreach, and;

WHEREAS, Logan Paul Gunderman is a Boy Scout from Troop Four, Greater Niagara Frontier Council, Boy Scouts of America, and has earned 21 merit badges on his way to attaining the coveted rank of Eagle Scout, Boy Scouting's highest honor, and;

WHEREAS, Logan Paul Gunderman's Eagle Service Project was to rebuild a trail and erect a sign leading to the Boy Scout pond in Hamburg for all the residence to use.
