#### **SUMMARY**

Legislative authorization is sought to retain CHA Consulting Inc to design a pedestrian bridge at Ellicott Creek Park. CHA Consulting Inc would also produce bid documents for this project.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

There is sufficient funding in Project A.17012 - 2017 County-wide Parks Improvements in Fund 410 to pay for the design phase. This phase is not to exceed \$23,000.

#### **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION**

CHA Consulting Inc is on the Department of Public Works approved vendor list and has the necessary experience and staff to perform this work.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry is looking for a vendor to design a pedestrian bridge at Ellicott Creek Park, as well as produce bid documents.

# **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

Without the necessary authorization in place, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry will be unable to hire CHA Consulting Inc to design a pedestrian bridge at Ellicott Creek Park, as well as bid out the necessary replacement of this structure. The bridge will need to be closed for the safety of the park visitors if it is not replaced.

# STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Upon approval of this resolution, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry will issue a contract to CHA Consulting Inc to design the pedestrian bridge at Ellicott Creek Park, as well as produce the bid documents.

RESOLVED, that the funding for the design phase of this project will not exceed \$23,000 and will be paid through Capital Project A.17012 – 2017 County-wide Parks Improvements, Fund 410, Funds Center 164, Account 516020 – Professional Services; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature shall forward certified copies of this Resolution to the County Executive; the Director of the Division of Budget and Management; the Erie County Comptroller; the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry, Daniel J. Rizzo; and Assistant County Attorney Kristen M. Walder.
