SUMMARY

The Erie County Legislature is requested to receive and file this communication pertaining to the Department of Environment and Planning's issuance of a work order with DiDonato Associates for Erie County Sewer District No. 4 in the amount not to exceed \$74,760.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Sewerage Management has issued work order DA-2 to DiDonato Associates to provide an engineering study for the Vanderbilt Pumping Station forcemain in Erie County Sewer District No. 4.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On December 15, 2016, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution authorizing a 3-year Term Agreement with DiDonato Associates for engineering services for small and/or time critical projects. At the time of the contract award, the Division of Sewerage Management committed to notifying the Honorable Legislature of each work order issued.


