#### SUMMARY

### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Sewerage Management has issued work order DA-2 to DiDonato Associates to provide an engineering study for the Vanderbilt Pumping Station forcemain in Erie County Sewer District No. 4.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

On December 15, 2016, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution authorizing a 3-year Term Agreement with DiDonato Associates for engineering services for small and/or time critical projects. At the time of the contract award, the Division of Sewerage Management committed to notifying the Honorable Legislature of each work order issued.

The Term Agreement was approved to provide the Division of Sewerage Management with engineering services required to complete various initiatives throughout the Erie County Sewer Districts. DiDonato Associates will be retained to provide an engineering study for the Vanderbilt Pumping Station forcemain in Erie County Sewer District No. 4.
