Dear Legislator Mills:

I'm writing today to alert you to the absolute deterioration of Zimmerman Road in the Town of Boston.

As you know, Zimmerman Road is an Erie County maintained road. It is difficult for drivers to navigate the many gaping holes in the road, as even trying to swerve around one makes them hit another. People are avoiding driving these routes, to be honest, I am as well. Residents should not have to consider detours or new routes in their daily routines taking their kids to and from school or as they go to and from work because the road conditions are so poor they worry about needing repairs to their vehicles. While there have been crews out putting cold patch in the road, this temporary solution will need to be addressed with a permanent solution as soon as possible as the current state of Zimmerman Road is unacceptable.

Citizens have been contacting my office not only complaining about the state of Zimmerman Road, but the overall maintenance of it throughout the winter. Again, while I know this has been an ongoing issue not just with Zimmerman Road, but with many of the Erie County maintained routes I am hoping with your help we can remedy the situation and rehabilitate these routes like you helped with last year's Boston/Springville Road.

I look forward to your response and any assistance you may be able to offer the Town of Boston as we are trying to ensure the safety of our community and make it a place others want to come instead of an eyesore on the local news for our crumbling road.

Thank you again for all you do for Boston, as the Town Supervisor, not only do I appreciate it, but I hear from all the residents who are grateful for your support.
