

**A RESOLUTION SUBMITTED BY  
LEGISLATOR MILLER-WILLIAMS**

**RE: REINSTATEMENT OF THE ERIE COUNTY COMMUNITY  
CORRECTIONS ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board (ECCCAB) is the discussion of current and potential programs and services to offer suggestions and advice for the improvement and implementation of such programs at the Erie County Correctional Facility and the Erie County Holding Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the ECCCAB may also receive public comment and complaints regarding the Correctional Facilities from interested parties to undertake functions and activities intended to make formal recommendations to the Erie County Legislature, Erie County Executive and the Erie County Sheriff on the improvement of functions of the Jail Management Division and the Erie County Holding Center and Correctional Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, Article V, Section III of the bylaws established to govern the ECCCAB states that regular meetings are to be held a minimum four times per year, with an annual meeting to be held in January of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Committee of the Erie County Legislature submitted a report on June 5, 2014 that included recommendations of individuals to serve on the ECCCAB, the Advisory Board has not held a meeting since August 6, 2013.

**NOW BE IT THEREFORE,**

**RESOLVED**, that the Erie County Legislature's Public Safety Committee shall reinstate the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Committee; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that recommendations of members to serve on the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board shall be forwarded to the Clerk of the Legislature by March 8, 2018 according to the standards set in the current by-laws of the Advisory Board.
