SUMMARY

The proposed resolution authorizes the addition of the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority to the established Exhibit B list of approved municipalities, schools and public entities allowed utilizing the County of Erie contracts create via the Division of Purchase.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

None to the County of Erie. However, the approval to utilize the County of Erie contracts through Purchasing can assist the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority to lower their operational costs.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The County's Purchasing Division has 91 Legislative approved public entities that utilize their contracts to date. This is request to approve the request to be added by the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Erie County Division of Purchase received a written request from the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority to be added to the Exhibit B listing. The Legislative approval is necessary as per Erie County Law 408-A to accomplish this act.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

No impact to the County of Erie. However, it will hinder the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority with the compliance needed to utilize the County of Erie, Division of Purchase's contracts and pricing.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority will be placed on the Exhibit B document that is included in every bid package and viewable to vendors.

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTED BY: DIVISION OF PURCHASE

RE: The Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority aka BMHA to Utilize County of Erie Purchase Contracts according County Law 408-A and Administrative Code 3.06 (c) (9)

WHEREAS, the County Law Section 408-A specifically authorizes the County Legislature to allow municipalities and special districts to make purchases through the County bidding procedure; and

WHEREAS, Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority have requested that the Director of Purchase be authorized to permit the these public entities to utilize County contracts for making purchases; and

WHEREAS, in most instances the provision of such services by the Erie County Division of Purchase will not create any additional cost or burdens upon said division, but will service to reduce the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority's operating costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of the Erie County Administrative Code Section 3.06 (c) (9) the following are hereby established as the conditions upon which the Purchasing Director may make purchasing services available the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority.

- 1. When in the opinion of the Director of Purchase it will not create any burden or hardship upon the County and the anticipated prices will not be adversely affected thereby, the Director is authorized when deemed appropriate and as may be requested by the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority to provide in any particular County bid specification that the participating municipalities and special districts in Erie County shall have the right to make purchases based upon the bids received by the County.
- 2. The County Purchasing Director within the limits of time and manpower shall disseminate relevant contract information to the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority.
- 3. Erie Community College and Monroe BOCES participating in County contracts will issue purchase orders directly to vendors with the specified contract period referencing the County contract involved and be liable for any payments due on such purchase orders.

AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the County Executive, the Division of Purchase, the Comptroller's Office and the Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority.

Your approval is requested for a resolution authorizing BMHA to "piggy back" on the contracts negotiated by the Eric County Division of Purchasing. Being able to purchase goods and supplies, where applicable, from these contracts would enable the Authority to reap the benefits of the lower prices available, without having to go through an RFP or other procurement process. This process is similar to that of obtaining goods and services through the State contract, which is also exempt from procurement requirements. Numerous local and national vendors are on the County list, and being able to participate with the County will result in substantial savings in terms of cost and staff time,
