## SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works, Division of Highways is seeking authorization for the County Executive to extend the existing contract for geographic information systems ("GIS") software, technical services and on-call services with Bergmann and Associates.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The Bergmann and Associates contract will not exceed \$150,000. Funding is available in the amount of \$150,000 in Funds Center 123, Fund 420, Capital Project B.17026 2017 Highway Searchable Data Base.

### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

Erie County Division of Highways ("Division") is operating below its potential due to significant gaps in information needed to support efficient operations and asset management. GIS has proven to be an excellent platform to catalog and detail the assets and operations for DPW.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Division maintains 294 bridges, 1200 centerline miles of roads, hundreds of pieces of equipment and hundreds of buildings. The age and lack of standardized data, high staff turn-over, time consuming asset research and the resulting reactive management cost the Division time and money. The Department needs to present information regarding road closures, restrictions and asset inventories utilizing GIS software and a searchable data base. The GIS software is required for filing reports for NYS and Federal agencies, as well as tracking asset life cycles and planning projects necessary to keep our facilities in working order.

# **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

Asset management, constituent response and pro-active planning are all handicapped by the lack of consistent and accurate data. Without the GIS technology the Division will continue to be inefficient and lack the data for responsive formal reporting.

## STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will execute a contract extension with Bergmann and Associates. Information from the engineering consultant will determine follow-up actions.

## COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

RESOLVED, that the County Executive be authorized to extend a contract with Bergmann and Associates for providing consulting services to assist DPW with the implementation of GIS technology in the Highways Division for an amount not to exceed \$150,000; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller's Office be authorized to make payments to Bergmann and Associates for the GIS Implementation of the searchable data base project from B.17026 – 2017 Highway Searchable Database, Fund 420, Funds Center 123; and be it further

RESOLVED, that five (5) certified copies of this resolution be sent to the Department of Public Works, Office of the Commissioner, and one copy each to the Office of the County Executive, the Division of Budget and Management, the Office of the Comptroller and the Division of Purchase.
