STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the County of Erie, State of New York, effective at 12:00 p.m. on the 15th day of March, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to the impact of the Global Pandemic related to the Coronavirus, the resulting illness COVID-19, and the aftereffects thereof.

The situation threatens the public's health, welfare, and safety.

The State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent order.

As the Chief Executive of the County of Erie, State of New York, I, Mark C. Poloncarz, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the County of Erie, State of New York, to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
