COUNTY EXECUTIVE
WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to authorize entering into contract for Cancer Services reimbursement from multiple sources with Great Lakes Imaging and United Memorial Medical Center for the provision of eligible clinical services to begin immediately upon approval of this resolution and extend through September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the provision of clinical services is based upon New York State Department of Health assigned rates for the Cancer Services Program of Erie County; and

WHEREAS, access to routine cancer screening is proven to reduce the mortality rate from cancer; and

WHEREAS, everyone, regarding of income or insurance status should have access to lifesaving cancer screening services and treatment; and

WHEREAS, the funds necessary to cover the costs of this contract have been appropriated in the 2017 Adopted Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into contract and amendments to that contract with Great Lakes Imaging and United Memorial Medical Center for the provision of eligible clinical services to begin immediately upon approval of this resolution and extend through September 30, 2018; and be it further

4. COMM. 16E-31 (2017)
COUNTY EXECUTIVE

WHEREAS, Erie County child protective services (“CPS”) investigates reports alleging child abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Charter School wants a CPS worker assigned to its school; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services has agreed to provide a CPS worker if Enterprise Charter School pays the local share costs of the employee; and

WHEREAS, the annual local share cost estimated at \$54,126 will be reimbursed by the Enterprise Charter School System and the balance reimbursed through State funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to contract with Enterprise Charter School to allow the Department of Social Services to accept funds for providing a dedicated Senior Child Protective Worker in their school; and be it further
