SHERIFF
WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security through the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has awarded \$153,420 for FY 12 to Erie County in funding to increase security along the Canadian border; and

WHEREAS, the Erie County Sheriff's Office will coordinate with Police Departments from the City of Buffalo, the Town of Cheektowaga, the Town of Evans, the Town of Hamburg, the City of Tonawanda, and the Town of Tonawanda to conduct joint law enforcement patrols in support of the U.S. Border Patrol's mission of apprehending terrorists and their weapons as they attempt to enter the United States illegally; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used for overtime for the participating law enforcement agencies, including the fringe benefits associated with it, and to purchase equipment required to support this program; and

WHEREAS, there will be no impact on County tax dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2013 all public safety radio systems operating in the 150-512 MHz radio bands must be operating utilizing narrowband technology, and
