Eligibility

Scholarship eligibility is open to high school seniors with a 2.5 (C+) average or better, who will attend a 2 or 4 year college/university in the fall 2012. Applicants must be a resident of Erie, Monroe, or Niagara Counties.

**** FBI Buffalo family members are ineligible to apply.***

The scholarship application must be postmarked by Friday, May11, 2012. Applications will be reviewed and the winner will be announced the week of June11th, 2012.
