#### **Eligibility**

Scholarship eligibility is open to high school seniors with a 2.5 (C+) average or better, who will attend a 2 or 4 year college/university in the fall 2012. Applicants must be a resident of Erie, Monroe, or Niagara Counties.

\* FBI Buffalo family members are ineligible to apply.

The scholarship application must be postmarked by Friday, May11, 2012. Applications will be reviewed and the winner will be announced the week of June 11th, 2012.
