Let's Make a Car-Toyota Plant Tour

Note: you must have a current passport, passport card, or enhanced driver' license as required by customs to participate in this trip.

First stop will be the Ancaster Old Mill Restaurant and enjoy a delicious lunch. Ancaster Mill's dining room has rustic beams and is built over the water-fall fed creek that gushes down from the Niagara escarpment. Entrée choice of either roasted chicken supreme or roasted top sirloin of beef au jus.

After lunch we will go to the state-of-the-art Visitor Centre at the Toyota Motor Manufacturing Plant and enjoy a short video presentation about the history and manufacturing methods of Toyota. Next we will embark on a motorized tram tour through their welding and/or assembly shops and see the team members and robots build the Matrix, Corolla, and Lexus.

Plant safety rules: Only natural fabrics may be worn (cotton, wool, silk, linen, etc.); no acrylic, polyester, rayon, or synthetic fibre clothing; no skirts, no open sandals or high-heeled shoes. (Cotton smocks will be provided if necessary). Visitor Centre requests that if you use a walker, or wheelchair that you indicate such when you sign up.

***Sonnenberg Gardens & Mansion and an Afternoon Cruise
on Canandaigua Lake***

Nestled in the picturesque Finger Lakes region of New York Sonnenberg Gardens is an historic park offering one of the few remaining estates in the US with Queen Anne-style mansion and nine formal gardens, including Japanese, rose, and Italian, etc. A tram ride is available around the estate as you enjoy a guided tour of grounds and mansion. Following the tour we will have lunch in the Canandaigua area.

After lunch we will head to Steamboat Landing for a narrated cruise on Canandaigua Lake. The Canandaigua Lady Paddle Wheel Boat is a 19th century replica of a double-decker steamboat, a proud successor to locally famous steamboats which operated on the finger Lakes between 1820 and 1930. The 60 ton Mississippi– style boat has recently been renovated and remodeled with an American theme. On the way home we will make an ice cream stop (individual expense).

The cost of this trip will be \$57 for residents and \$77 for nonresidents.
