

Akron Airport: The Article 78 action was filed and the town had been discussing possible agreements with the airport. The Town Board and Zoning Board met last week to discuss their options in an executive session and have now decided to hire outside council to look at the case. They are hiring an attorney with extensive background in Article 78 proceedings. They will keep the Village Board up to date on any progress.

Village Subdivision updates:

Hake & Clarence Center Rds-There has been no forward movement of progress. Jackson & Hake- the street binder curbing and water & sewer are in. They are waiting to receive PIP fees and then the electrical work will start. The project is proceeding well.

Joint Emergency Services Committee: The committee needs to set a meeting date soon. Committee members are Mayor Patterson and Trustee Wittlinger for the Village and Councilman Rooney and Councilman Baran for the Town.

Annexation of Cowan property: no new movement has been made on this. The Village Board wanted to make it very clear that even if the property is annexed into the Village it will not receive the Village electric, unless it is run at the homeowner's expense to the property.

Murder Creek- the DEC Water Quality grant work on erosion and eddys is set to begin in the spring. The FEMA grant work will continue as well with watering and monitoring plantings for a 2 year period.

Wastewater Treatment Plant expansion: the Village is looking at some possible grant monies they may be eligible for if the Town is willing to go in on an Engineering Study with them for expansion of the sewer lines into some areas of the town bordering the village. Everyone seemed to be in agreement that this could move forward.

The next meeting will be May 7, 2012 at the Town Hall.

The Mayor thanked everyone for coming. The meeting was adjourned at 9:07pm by the Supervisor & Mayor.
