Hay Wagon Application

Fees: \$100 / day for each hay wagon

Hay wagons require the user to provide their own heavy duty vehicle equipped for towing (i.e. a tractor, F-350, etc.) and require a 2-5/16" ball hitch

Permits will not be issued until this office receives:

1. Check or money order payable to the 'Erie County Parks' in the amount of \$100.00/day for each hay wagon rented.
2. Certificate of Insurance listing the County of Erie as additional insured
3. Must provide security plan for the hay wagon if the hay wagon is staying at a location for multiple days.
4. **NO DUCT TAPE, SCREWS OR NAILS CAN BE USED ON HAY WAGON**
