Outdoor Recreational Equipment Permit Application
(i.e. Bounce House or Tent)

- 1. Availability of Space: In order for The Department of Parks to approve equipment, there must first be space in your shelter area without infringing on another shelter's space.
2. Insurance: You must have the company that you are renting your equipment from provide us with an insurance certificate listing Erie County as additional insured, carrying a minimum of \$1 million of liability coverage, as well as listing the date and area where you will be.

- 3. Bounce House Supervision: A QUALIFIED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EQUIPMENT COMPANY MUST SUPERVISE USE OF THE EQUIPMENT AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN USE IN THE PARK. Thus, you need to pay not only for the rental, but an employee to supervise its use.
4. Tents: Only 1 (one) tent per shelter allowed. Must be flame retardant. Permit is required if tent is larger than 10' x 10.'

Complete this application, and mail or fax (858-8314) with insurance form and a permit will be mailed or e-mailed to you. The park will also receive a copy of the permit.
