1. Annual Exam – this also includes pre-employment and exit exam, along with the annual medical surveillance OSHA Exam for <u>Interior Fire Fighters</u>	\$35.00
To Include: Exposure history, physician exam, height, weight, blood pressure, vision and hearing testing.	
2. Asbestos Physical Exam and Testing	\$45.00
To Include: Medical and work history with special emphasis directed to the pulmonary and Gastrointestinal systems, including a chest roentgenogram to be administered at the discretion of the physician, and pulmonary function tests of forced Vital capacity (FVC) and forced expiratory volume at one second (FEV (1).
