**TO PROVIDE an Interface to the New York State Integrated Justice Portal**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The County of Erie, New York (the “County”) is currently seeking Proposal Statements from qualified software engineers interested in providing customized computer software components that will interface existing software programs in Erie County with the New York State Integrated Justice Portal. Proposers interested in providing a software solution are invited to respond to this request.

It is the County's intent to select the Proposer that provides the best solution for the County's needs.

**A. OVERVIEW**

Currently, Erie County’s Department of Central Police Services (CPS) maintains a suite of custom written Law Enforcement software packages for use by a myriad of Public Safety Agencies throughout and near Erie County. These agencies include, but are not limited to, local (City, Town and Village) police and fire departments, County Sheriff Offices, County departments such as Probation, Emergency Services and the District Attorney, along with State and Federal agencies. These software packages are continually being enhanced and modified to meet the needs of the user community by County staff consisting of programmers, analysts and database administrators.

Currently, three of the software packages (clients) communicate with an interface program named “DATASERVER.exe”. DATASERVER, in turn, sends and receives messages with the New York Statewide Police Information Network (NYSPIN) using a Metro Connection, also referred to as a Server-to-Server Interface. In addition, some user agencies have custom built clients that send requests and receive responses from DATASERVER.

The Metro connection is at end of life and has been replaced by NYS with an Integrated Justice Portal (IJP), which uses web services.

CPS needs to:

(A) Either replace or enhance the existing DATASERVER software with functionality that sends requests to the IJP web service and implements web services to process the responses. All processes must meet the certificate validation required by the IJP Web Services Specification located at <http://troopers.ny.gov/iepd/>.

(B) Modify the three existing client programs (Mobiles, CHARMS and Countywide ENTCAD) to accept the IJP data and display it accordingly

The County reserves the right to consider two separate vendors for items (A) and (B), however greater weight will be given to a vendor who can complete both tasks.

Due to the sensitive nature of the data that will be passed between these programs and New York State, any vendor staff assigned to this project will be required to undergo, at the vendor's cost, fingerprinting by an authorized center, such as Morpho Trust/L1.

## **B. EXPECTED OUTCOMES/GOALS**

CPS has a staff of software professionals that will continue to enhance and maintain software that is in turn provided, free of charge, to Public Safety agencies. To that goal, all custom work accomplished under this project must be developed in an agreed upon software language as detailed in Section III of this RFP. In addition, all work must be documented both within the code and in a technical specification document to allow for future modifications when needed by CPS staff, or any consultant who may be under contract in the future with the County of Erie. As stated in Section IV, under the heading of Intellectual Property Rights, all resulting software, in all forms it takes (including, but not limited to, machine readable object code and source code forms) will be the property of the County of Erie.

New York State maintains a website: <http://troopers.ny.gov/iepd/> that has the most up-to-date information on the National Information Exchange Model (NIEM)-conformant Information Exchange Package Documentations (IEPDs) for the purpose of building approved web service message exchanges by authorized agencies. The award will be based the best solution meeting specifications defined on the IJP website. It is the vendor's responsibility to stay informed of any updates to this website. A List of changes can be found in the [NYSP Metro Web Service Change Log](#).

Finally, all deliverables must meet the standards of security as outlined in the Criminal Justice Information Security (CJIS) Security Policy which can be found on the New York State website at [http://troopers.ny.gov/iepd/CJIS\\_Security\\_Policy.pdf](http://troopers.ny.gov/iepd/CJIS_Security_Policy.pdf).

The County reserves the right to amend this RFP. The County reserves the right to reject any or all of the proposals, or any part thereof, submitted in response to this RFP, and reserves the right to waive formalities, if such action is deemed to be in the best interest of the County. The County reserves the right to request additional information from any proposer. The County reserves the right to award negotiated contracts to one or more proposers.

This RFP is not intended and shall not be construed to commit the County to pay any costs incurred in connection with any proposal or to procure or contract with any firm.

The County will only contract with firms that do not discriminate against employees or applicants for employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, citizenship status or any other status protected by New York State and Federal laws.

## **II. PROPOSAL PROCEDURES**

### **A. ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE OF PROPOSAL**

## **B. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

1. Each proposal shall be prepared simply and economically avoiding the use of elaborate promotional materials beyond what is sufficient to provide a complete, accurate and reliable presentation.
2. One (1) original and two (2) copies shall be submitted. Proposals MUST be signed. Unsigned proposals will be rejected. An electronic copy in Microsoft Word on a CD, DVD, Flash Drive, or any other electronic media is also required.

**All proposals must be delivered to the above office on or before July 21, 2014 at [ 1:00] p.m. Proposals received after the above date and time will not be considered. The County is under no obligation to return proposals.**

4. Requests for clarification of this RFP must be written and submitted to Marlaine Hoffman at Marlaine.Hoffman@erie.gov no later than 12 pm on July 10, 2014. Formal written responses to these questions will be distributed via email by the County on or before July 18, 2014. NO COMMUNICATIONS OF ANY KIND WILL BE BINDING AGAINST THE COUNTY, EXCEPT FOR THE FORMAL WRITTEN RESPONSES TO ANY REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION.
5. Proposers may be required to give an oral presentation to the County to clarify or elaborate on the written proposal. Those proposers will be notified to arrange specific times.
6. No proposal will be accepted from nor any agreement awarded to any proposer that is in arrears upon any debt or in default of any obligation owed to the County. Additionally, no agreement will be awarded to any proposer that has failed to satisfactorily perform pursuant to any prior agreement with the County.
7. **Certified Minority Business Enterprise/Women's Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) proposers should include the Erie County certification letter with the proposal.**

8. If proposer is a Veteran Owned Business, proposer should include letter indicating company is 51% or more Veteran-owned.

### **III. SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES REQUIRED**

#### **A. SUMMARY**

1. The Project has two distinct, but related pieces. A vendor may submit a proposal for one or both of the items.

**1.1 DATASERVER:** the replacement or enhancement of the existing DATASERVER software, which will communicate with the New York State IJP using web services, and with the software listed in Item 1.2.

**1.2 CLIENTS:** modifications to the existing, production, Client software programs known as Countywide ENTCAD, CHARMS and Mobiles to accept the data from the enhanced DATASERVER or its replacement and display it to the user in an acceptable manner. A list of the transactions required for this project is contained in Schedule D. This list uses a spreadsheet provided by NYS, with a column added indicating the transactions required by Erie County CPS. Your solution can include additional transactions not listed in the Schedule. Please note: not all of these transactions are currently supported in the three client programs mentioned in this section. As a result, new screens/forms may need to be developed within the Client programs to accommodate these additional transactions. The clients will communicate with the enhanced or replaced DATASERVER, which will interface with IJP as per the IJP specs.

1.2.1 **Other Clients:** as mentioned in the Overview, some police agencies have developed other clients that need to send requests to DATASERVER and receive replies. Examples are Buffalo PD's Mobiles, ENTCAD and Charms, along with Buffalo State College's AutoPark System and a new project for the suburban agencies to print parking tags in the field. The proposed solution must be able to accept these requests and send the responses to the appropriate client.

2. The awarded vendor must demonstrate knowledge of the current software packages running in Erie County and the web services methodology employed by New York State's Integrated Justice Portal.

## B. COMPATIBILITY OF SOLUTION

1. **Current Environment:** Central Police Services is in a state of transition with regard to its development environment. Until recently, all software was developed in Borland C++ Builder 6. At the time of this RFP, an effort is underway to update all core programs to C++ XE5. Components (3<sup>rd</sup> party IDE add-ons) compatible with version C++ XE5 by Embarcadero are being tested and evaluated. It is important that CPS staff be able to maintain and enhance the system in the future. As a result, any components in the vendor's proposed solution must be approved by Erie County.
2. **System Flow:** A high-level of the current system's data flow diagram is included as Schedule C. Erie County is open to suggestions to improve the flow of data.
3. **Audit Trail:** The current system stores both the request and the response from NYS in a table, along with date/time and information used to identify the requestor. This table is used as an audit trail. The new system must provide the same functionality. It is preferred to continue to use the same tables, but not mandatory.

## C. DELIVERABLES

### 1. Contact and Vendor Information

**1.1 Contact Information:** Include the contact information for the person who is responsible for the preparation of your response. Include mailing address, email address and telephone contact information. This is the person we will contact with any questions.

**1.6 References:** Provide the name and contact information (phone and email address) of individuals who can talk knowledgably about your organization's service and performance with systems similar to the one you are proposing for Erie County. Do not include as a reference any organization that would not consent to a site visit.

### 2. Narrative

**2.1.** Provide a detailed narrative of your proposed system. Include how your system will help Erie County reach its desired outcome and goals stated in Section I.



- 13. Miscellaneous:** State any other items that should be considered by Erie County for this solution.
- 14. Time Period:** This project is being funded under a grant that expires on March 1, 2015. Please state your intention to finish, deliver and test all work by Feb 15, 2015. Note: the County will require the specifications needed to communicate with any clients within 30 days of contract acceptance in a written document with sufficient detail to allow for the work on Items A-1.2 and A-1.2.1 to begin.
- 15. Acceptance:** Erie County will not make final payment until an Acceptance Agreement is signed by the County. Schedule E is an example of an Acceptance Agreement. State any changes you will require to this document.
- 16. Quality Control:** State your policy on any problems, errors or bugs uncovered after Erie County signs the Acceptance Agreement.

  - 18.4.** Any additional items needed for your solution to succeed. Please state Not Applicable if no additional items needed.

#### **IV. STATEMENT OF RIGHTS**

##### **UNDERSTANDINGS**

**Please take notice**, by submission of a proposal in response to this request for proposals, the proposer agrees to and understands:

- that any proposal, attachments, additional information, etc. submitted pursuant to this Request for Proposals constitute merely a suggestion to negotiate with the County of Erie and is not a bid under Section 103 of the New York State General Municipal Law;
- submission of a proposal, attachments, and additional information shall not entitle the proposer to enter into an agreement with the County of Erie for the required services;
- by submitting a proposal, the proposer agrees and understands that the County of Erie is not obligated to respond to the proposal, nor is it legally bound in any manner whatsoever by submission of same;
- that any and all counter-proposals, negotiations or any communications received by a proposing entity, its officers, employees or agents from the County, its elected officials, officers, employees or agents, shall not be binding against the County of Erie, its elected officials, officers, employees or agents unless and until a formal written agreement for the services sought by this RFP is duly executed by both parties and approved by the Erie County Legislature, the Erie County Fiscal Stability Authority, and the Office of the Erie County Attorney.

In addition to the foregoing, by submitting a proposal, the proposer also understands and agrees that the County of Erie reserves the right, and may at its sole discretion exercise, the following rights and options with respect to this Request for Proposals:

- To reject any or all proposals;
- To issue amendments to this RFP;
- To issue additional solicitations for proposals
- To waive any irregularities in proposals received after notification to proposers affected;
- To select any proposal as the basis for negotiations of a contract, and to negotiate with one or more of the proposers for amendments or other modifications to their proposals;
- To conduct investigations with respect to the qualifications of each proposer;
- To exercise its discretion and apply its judgment with respect to any aspect of this RFP, the evaluation of proposals, and the negotiations and award of any contract;
- To enter into an agreement for only portions (or not to enter into an agreement for any) of the services contemplated by the proposals with one or more of the proposers;
- To select the proposal that best satisfies the interests of the County and not necessarily on the basis of price or any other single factor;
- To interview the proposer(s);

- To request or obtain additional information the County deems necessary to determine the ability of the proposer;
- To modify dates;
- All proposals prepared in response to this RFP are at the sole expense of the proposer, and with the express understanding that there will be no claim, whatsoever, for reimbursement from the County for the expenses of preparation. The County assumes no responsibility or liability of any kind for costs incurred in the preparation or submission of any proposal;
- While this is a RFP and not a bid, the County reserves the right to apply the case law under General Municipal Law § 103 regarding bidder responsibility in determining whether a proposer is a responsible vendor for the purpose of this RFP process;
- The County is not responsible for any internal or external delivery delays which may cause any proposal to arrive beyond the stated deadline. To be considered, proposals **MUST** arrive at the place specified herein and be time stamped prior to the deadline

## **EVALUATION**

The following criteria, not necessarily listed in order of importance, will be used to review the proposals. The County reserves the right to weigh its evaluation criteria in any manner it deems appropriate:

- Proposer's demonstrated capability to provide the services.
- Evaluation of the professional qualifications, personal background and resume(s) of individuals involved in providing services.
- Proposer's experience to perform the proposed services.
- Proposer's financial ability to provide the services.
- Evaluation of the proposer's fee submission. It should be noted that while price is not the only consideration, it is an important one.
- A determination that the proposer has submitted a complete and responsive proposal as required by this RFP.
- An evaluation of the proposer's projected approach and plans to meet the requirements of this RFP.
- The proposer's presentation at and the overall results of any interview conducted with the proposer.

- Proposers MUST sign the Proposal Certification attached hereto as Schedule “A”. Unsigned proposals will be rejected.
- Proposers may be required to give an oral presentation to the County to clarify or elaborate on the written proposal.
- No proposal will be accepted from nor any agreement awarded to any proposer that is in arrears upon any debt or in default of any obligation owed to the County. Additionally, no agreement will be awarded to any proposer that has failed to satisfactorily perform pursuant to any prior agreement with the County.

## **CONTRACT**

After selection of the successful proposer, a formal written contract will be prepared by the County of Erie and will not be binding until signed by both parties and, if necessary, approved by the Erie County Legislature, the Erie County Fiscal Stability Authority and the Office of the County Attorney. **NO RIGHTS SHALL ACCRUE TO ANY PROPOSER BY THE FACT THAT A PROPOSAL HAS BEEN SELECTED BY THE COUNTY FOR SUBMISSION TO THE ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE AND/OR THE ERIE COUNTY FISCAL STABILITY AUTHORITY FOR APPROVAL. THE APPROVAL OF SAID LEGISLATURE AND/OR AUTHORITY MAY BE NECESSARY BEFORE A VALID AND BINDING CONTRACT MAY BE EXECUTED BY THE COUNTY.**

## **INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE**

The proposer accepts and agrees that language in substantially the following form will be included in the contract between the proposer and the County:

“In addition to, and not in limitation of the insurance requirements contained herein the Consultant agrees:

(a) that except for the amount, if any, of damage contributed to, caused by or resulting from the negligence of the County, the Consultant shall indemnify and hold harmless the County, its officers, employees and agents from and against any and all liability, damage, claims, demands, costs, judgments, fees, attorneys' fees or loss arising directly or indirectly out of the acts or omissions hereunder by the Consultant or third parties under the direction or control of the Consultant; and

(b) to provide defense for and defend, at its sole expense, any and all claims, demands or causes of action directly or indirectly arising out of this Agreement and to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto.

Upon execution of any contract between the proposer and the County, the proposer will be required to provide proof of the insurance coverage described in Schedule “B”.

Insurance coverage in amount and form shall not be deemed acceptable until approved by the County Attorney.

## INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

**The proposer accepts and agrees that language in substantially the following form will be included in the contract between the proposer and the County:**

**All deliverables created under this Agreement by the Consultant are to be considered “works made for hire”. If any of the deliverables do not qualify as “works made for hire”, the Consultant hereby assigns to the County all right, title and interest (including ownership of copyright) in such deliverables and such assignment allows the County to obtain in its name copyrights, registrations and similar protections which may be available. The Consultant agrees to assist the County, if required, in perfecting these rights. The Consultant shall provide the County with at least one copy of each deliverable.**

**The Consultant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County for all damages, liabilities, losses and expenses arising out of any claim that a deliverable infringes upon an intellectual property right of a third party. If such a claim is made, or appears likely to be made, the Consultant agrees to enable the County’s continued use of the deliverable, or to modify or replace it. If the County determines that none of these alternatives is reasonably available, the deliverable will be returned.**

**All records compiled by the Consultant in completing the work described in this Agreement, including but not limited to written reports, source codes, studies, drawings, blueprints, negatives of photographs, computer printouts, graphs, charts, plans, specifications and all other similar recorded data, shall become and remain the property of the County. The Consultant may retain copies of such records for its own use.**

## NON-COLLUSION

The proposer, by signing the proposal, does hereby warrant and represent that any ensuing agreement has not been solicited, secured or prepared directly or indirectly, in a manner contrary to the laws of the State of New York and the County of Erie, and that said laws have not been violated and shall not be violated as they relate to the procurement or the performance of the agreement by any conduct, including the paying or the giving of any fee, commission, compensation, gift, gratuity or consideration of any kind, directly or indirectly, to any County employee, officer or official.

## CONFLICT OF INTEREST

All proposers must disclose with their proposals the name of any officer, director or agent who is also an employee of the County of Erie. Further, all proposers must disclose the name of any County employee who owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of ten percent or more in the firm or any of its subsidiaries or affiliates.

There shall be no conflicts in existence during the term of any contract with the County. The existence of a conflict shall be grounds for termination of a contract.

## **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS**

By submitting a proposal, the proposer represents and warrants that it is familiar with all federal, state and local laws and regulations and will conform to said laws and regulations. The preparation of proposals, selection of proposers and the award of contracts are subject to provisions of all Federal, State and County laws, rules and regulations.

## **CONTENTS OF PROPOSAL**

The New York State Freedom of Information Law as set forth in Public Officers Law, Article 6, Sections 84 et seq., mandates public access to government records. However, proposals submitted in response to this RFP may contain technical, financial background or other data, public disclosure of which could cause substantial injury to the proposer's competitive position or constitute a trade secret. Proposers who have a good faith belief that information submitted in their proposals is protected from disclosure under the New York Freedom of Information Law shall:

- a) insert the following notice in the front of its proposal:

### **“NOTICE**

**The data on pages \_\_\_\_ of this proposal identified by an asterisk (\*) contains technical or financial information constituting trade secrets or information the disclosure of which would result in substantial injury to the proposer’s competitive position.**

**The proposer requests that such information be used only for the evaluation of the proposal, but understands that any disclosure will be limited to the extent that the County considers proper under the law. If the County enters into an agreement with this proposer, the County shall have the right to use or disclose such information as provided in the agreement, unless otherwise obligated by law.”**

and

- b) clearly identify the pages of the proposals containing such information by typing in bold face on the top of each page " **\* THE PROPOSER BELIEVES THAT THIS INFORMATION IS PROTECTED FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE STATE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION LAW.**"

The County assumes no liability for disclosure of information so identified, provided that the County has made a good faith legal determination that the information is not protected from disclosure under applicable law or where disclosure is required to comply with an order or judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction.

The contents of the proposal which is accepted by the County, except portions "Protected from Disclosure", may become part of any agreement resulting from this RFP.

## **EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF PROPOSALS**

All proposals must state the period for which the proposal shall remain in effect (i.e. how much time does the County have to accept or reject the proposal under the terms proposed). Such period shall not be less than 180 days from the proposal date.

**SCHEDULE "A"**

**PROPOSER CERTIFICATION**

The undersigned agrees and understands that this proposal and all attachments, additional information, etc. submitted herewith constitute merely an offer to negotiate with the County of Erie and is NOT A BID. Submission of this proposal, attachments, and additional information shall not obligate or entitle the proposing entity to enter into a service agreement with the County of Erie for the required services. The undersigned agrees and understands that the County of Erie is not obligated to respond to this proposal nor is it legally bound in any manner whatsoever by the submission of same. Further, the undersigned agrees and understands that any and all proposals and negotiations shall not be binding or valid against the County of Erie, its directors, officers, employees or agents unless an agreement is signed by a duly authorized officer of the County of Erie and, if necessary, approved by the Erie County Legislature and Erie County Fiscal Stability Authority and the Office of the County Attorney.

It is understood and agreed that the County of Erie reserves the right to reject consideration of any and all proposals including, but not limited to, proposals which are conditional or incomplete. It is further understood and agreed that the County of Erie reserves all rights specified in the Request for Proposals.

It is represented and warranted by those submitting this proposal that except as disclosed in the proposal, no officer or employee of the County of Erie is directly or indirectly a party to or in any other manner interested in this proposal or any subsequent service agreement that may be entered into.


