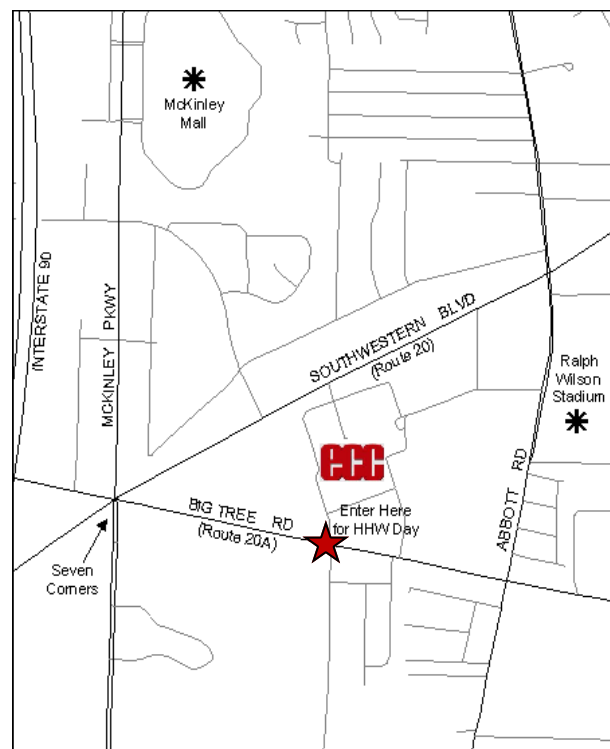

Items which can be brought to the site for free,
proper disposal include:

- ◆ PESTICIDES, FERTILIZERS, POOL AND HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS/CLEANERS -limit 2 gallons or 20#
- ◆ OIL-BASED PAINTS, SPRAY CANS -limit 10 gallons
- ◆ OIL, GASOLINE, KEROSENE, ANTIFREEZE -limit 10 gallons
- ◆ PAINT THINNER, STRIPPER & SOLVENTS -limit 2 gallons
- ◆ BATTERIES - lead acid & rechargeable
- ◆ MERCURY - thermometers, thermostats, other
- ◆ PROPANE TANKS & PROPANE CYLINDERS - full or empty



NO: LATEX PAINT, TIRES, LIGHT BULBS, COMPUTERS, PHARMACEUTICAL, COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL WASTE
