

The income standard for Emergency Safety Net Assistance (ESNA) and Emergency Assistance to Needy Families with Children (EAF) is tied to the official Federal Poverty Guidelines which are updated annually by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

**Emergency Safety Net Assistance**

Financial eligibility for ESNA is 125% of the official Federal Poverty Guidelines. The following new guidelines for ESNA are effective April 1, 2014, through March 31, 2015.
