All counties gave an update on what they are doing. Paul LaDouceur gave update on NYSDOH immunization issues and Robert Viets gave a NYSACHO update. Paul will be doing hospital perinatal reviews remotely through EMR's and giving reports back via phone conferences. He will do periodic reviews with counties in person. New this year will be the accountability of time for IAP grants and the reporting of "in kind" expenses directly. Thru NYSACHO, there will be adds on the back of buses and radio ads this year promoting flu vaccination. • Forever Young Health Fair: date is 10/27/16 and Karen sending around sign-up sheet for members to sign up to work 3 hour blocks of time. 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<p>NYSDOH Update</p> <p>Lead Update</p> <p>County Update</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CDC Vaccine webinars have concluded at the end of September: they are archived on the CDC site. • Fall 2016 Clinical Vaccinology Course: November 4-6 in Philadelphia, PA. • 10/11/16: AFIX to Empower Clinicians to Increase HPV Vaccine rates- with recommendation of it as the pre-teen and adolescent series. <p>Other New Business:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Medimmune Sales rep. is Thomas Wysocki. • SAVE THE DATE: NYSACHO holding annual Statewide Immunization and Consortia Meeting March 28-29, 2017 at the Radisson Hotel in Albany. • Karen M., Karen S. and Gia gave highlights from the CDC National Conference. The bundling of adolescent vaccines was highly recommended as being an effective approach to increase HPV vaccinations. Karen S. brought back some handouts, posters and vaccine workbooks to share, as well as flu posters from TAPI on the differences between the Flu and the common cold. • Commissioner of Health 2016-2017 statement made: Vaccine Supply is adequate and give thimerosal-free flu vaccine to pregnant women and children under age of 3. • NYSDOH emailed information for schools and child-care facilities, requiring them to post influenza education. <p>Renee Nealy gave the NYSDOH report. She noted that the survey for Freezer grant agreements must be signed off by October 14, 2016. The freezer agreement is for providers who want stand-alone freezers. The technical data sheet contains information on the space necessary to accommodate the freezer.</p> <p>S. Kellner noted that the city of Buffalo is expanding enforcement of lead requirements and increasing home inspections. There is a new 311 direct line for lead calls and new educational requirements via Buffalo Public Schools. ECDOH is expanding case management of lead levels between 5 and 9 and there is new funding for educational interventions. They have also hired 1 full time nurse.</p> <p>Erie County: all 23 AFIX's completed. Remains busy with immunization clinics. Completed promotions at Niagara Falls Blvd. and Galleria malls over past 4-6 weeks. Influenza promotion will be featured mid-November-Dec. display at same malls.</p> <p>Niagara County: Busy with immunization clinics and employee flu clinic.
