Dr. Kristen Feemster Research Director, Vaccine Education Center Children's Hospital of Philadelphia

Dr. Feemster is an attending physician in the Division of Infectious Diseases and Director of Research for the Vaccine Education Center at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Her expertise is in epidemiology of vaccine preventable diseases with a focus on community and social factors, global and domestic vaccine policy, and vaccine hesitancy. Dr. Feemster serves on the boards of the Philadelphia and Pennsylvania Immunization Coalitions.

Dr. Leonard Friedland GlaxoSmithKline

Dr. Friedland, Vice President, Director of Scientific Affairs and Public Health, GSK Vaccines, is a pediatrician and research scientist who is passionate about vaccines. He has published 45 peer review articles and has written many book chapters on healthcare and vaccination topics. At GSK Dr. Friedland is involved in the development of vaccines for use in children and adults. He is GSK's medical and public health representative and spokesperson for US vaccine topics at CDC and other public health venues.

Dr. Peter Frederick Department of Gynecologic Oncology Roswell Park Cancer Center

Dr. Frederick has been on the faculty of Roswell Park in the Department of Gynecologic Oncology since 2010. His areas of clinical interest include all cancers of the female reproductive system, including uterine, ovarian, cervical, vulvar and vaginal cancer. He is the Director of Minimally Invasive Surgery for the Department of Gynecologic Oncology and has taken the leading role in developing and promoting the robotics program at Roswell Park Cancer Center.

Ethan Lindenberger Vaccine Advocate

In February 2019, 18-year old Norwalk, Ohio high school senior Ethan testified in front of the Senate Committee of Health, Education, Labor and Pensions about how he decided to get immunized against his mother's beliefs. Ethan grew up without receiving any of the common pediatric/adolescent vaccination, and is now advocating for informed knowledge re: vaccine safety.

Jamie Schanbaum GSK Patient Vaccine Advocate

US Paralympian/ Meningitis Survivor Jamie is a GSK spokesperson who educates parents and young adults about the dangers of meningitis and the vaccines available to help prevent it. In 2011 she won a gold medal at the US Paralympic games for cycling.

Dr. Candice Robinson Medical Officer Centers for Disease Control

Dr. Robinson is an officer with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and works in the Immunization Services Division. She provides education on vaccines and vaccine preventable diseases to state and local immunization programs, develops informational and educational materials and is a liaison to the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices.

NYS Assoc. of County Health Officials (NYSACHO)

As the Program/Project Manager at NYSACHO since 2006, Robert is the primary contact for immunization grant activities, including the management and planning for all immunization-related educational activities and meetings. He is also the lead staff person for NYSACHO's Disease Control and Emerging Issues Committee on non-advocacy related issues.
