<p>New Business</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Voices for Vaccine- released a new POD Cast in Vax Talk- Superman, Cancer, and Vaccines. Jason Mendelsohn tells his story. • IAC Updates Influenza Vaccine Products for 2018-2019 Flu Season- copies passed around. Renee discussed the CDC website and discussed types of questions about flu. • Discussed the passing of Lynn Bozof-creator of the National Meningitis Association., due to pancreatic cancer. • AAP released new videos- one features pediatricians sharing why they vaccinate and another addressing the importance of the hepatitis B vaccine birth dose. • Book “Plotkin’s Vaccines” won first prize in the Public Health category. The first edition was in 1988. • IAC updated the adult vaccination site at immunize.org. • CDC guidance re: Shingrix supply-remind them of importance of getting second dose, refer them to other providers in the community (pharmacy), call eligible patients for first dose when supply is less constrained. Chris Hayes discussed the Shingrix supply issue- the state is giving the VFA program 10 doses at a time. The vaccine is backordered- can order 20 doses in packs of 10 or 10 doses in one pack. The CDC is discouraging stocking up on the vaccine. Second dose is a priority. With Medicare Part D only get at a pharmacy 		
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<p>New Business (continued)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beware of B Campaign- urging Big Ten universities to require the Men B vaccine for incoming students. There is a video available to watch that shows the devastation of meningitis and the importance of getting vaccinated. Since 2011 100% of meningitis outbreaks on campuses have been Men B. • Draft for October ACIP meeting in available. October 24-25 • Every Child by Two-Russia has a Vaccination Problem-September 28 publication. • Congo- launches a 6 day campaign to vaccinate more than 1 million people 9 months and older with yellow fever vaccine. This started on 9/26/18- in Pointe Noire and surrounding areas. • Flu broke records for death and illnesses in 2017-2018-80,000 people sick and died according to the CDC. 80% of the children that died had not had a flu vaccine. • Anti-vaccine in Russia- women in Russia make the decisions- 48% in 2016 were not vaccinated. Alexander Kotox is a big anti-vaccine person in Russia that people are following. Causing increase in disease due to anti vaccine people. Putin considering enforcing rule for vaccines. • Article shared about nurse in Missouri putting up billboards claiming that vaccines killed her son. There are 30 plus billboards in Missouri. • ALEXA educates about the flu! Article shared re: this. • Alexander Barr with NYSACHO – to help with coalition projects. • CDC – On Time Vaccination- the ultimate baby proofing plan – to prevent prolonged vaccine schedules. • CDC found that rural areas were less likely to vaccinate for HPV vaccine than urban areas. HPV 11% lower in rural areas than urban areas.
