To whom it may concern,

The leaders of the community service pillar at Alden High School would like to partner with Alden town leadership in regard to installing a dog park in our town's community. In doing this we strive to create a comfortable, community enriching space to encourage socialization and exercise for dogs and their owners alike.

Benefits of the installation of a dog park in Alden begin with the demonstration of pride, assertion, teamwork, and service Alden High School students will gain as the community service pillar welcomes all students to become involved in this wonderful goal. Outside of our school district, a designated space for community members and their pets to gather gives further opportunities for community building, as well as a higher influence in outdoor recreation. The installation of an off-leash area for owners to take their pets will likely strengthen compliance to town leash laws in surrounding spaces. A facility such as this will also provide owners an area to further train their dogs safely, as to ensure a greater welfare of pets and community members they may encounter.

Many surrounding communities have proceeded to install their own doggy play spaces, such as Knox Farm Dog Park in East Aurora, Amherst Paw Park, Geneseo Dog Park, and the latest addition to our area, Como Lake Bark Park in Lancaster. The installation of a dog park in our own town will very likely increase the value of the park itself as well as surrounding neighborhoods, just how it has in these other local districts. Furthermore, the draw-in of a dog park to other towns will increase outside appeal and their member's visitation to Alden's town businesses and events.

The pillar would like to pursue a donation of land for this public space of recreation to be built upon. In our pillar's vision, we believe that the dog park may be enjoyed to its greatest extent in our very own town park, where many pet owners already regularly bring their dogs to walk the park's beautiful trails. We believe the ideal setting for Alden Bulldog's dog park may involve the area across from the Joe Panza Nature Trail, on the lower hill level of the park. This would also be a great location as it is easily accessible for Alden students during volunteering opportunities, as well as community members who live in Alden's village. However, any area suggested by the Alden Town Board would be greatly appreciated.

Without the cost of land and depending on the agreed upon size and regulations put out by the Alden Town Board, an estimated cost for the installation of a dog park would likely land between \$10,000 and \$25,000. In terms of funding, the community service pillar plans to separate fundraising into 3 different categories. The first category of funding will be designated for sponsored donations by local companies and organizations. The pillar's cause has already been pledged up to a five-thousand-dollar donation by the town's local Blackwater Pragmatic. After confirmation that our project is a go, the pillar is prepared to reach out further and request donations from more organizations. Our second planned category of fundraising will be direct town fundraisers through Alden High School's community service pillar. We have ideas such as an online cutest puppy contest, a furry friends walk-a-thon, and a personalized brick for dog park

path fundraiser. Our third and final category for funding would look to Alden High School's students, clubs, and classes for possible donations. Some examples of groups that would be eager to help include, but are not limited to, the Friends of the Planet club, KEY Club, Bulldog Manufacturing, as well as leadership classes.

We believe that with our solid plan and community support, our goal can be completed by summer of 2023. The pillar's mission has already garnered support from Alden High School administration. Our next steps are to reach agreeable details, space, regulations, and preservation measures with your leadership.

The high school's community service pillar is beyond excited to be sharing this idea with our town's leaders. Our goal is to assist and benefit the lives of our fellow students and our great community and it is our strong belief that this project can do just that. We greatly appreciate your time in reviewing our requests, as well as any time invested in our alliance and your assistance in the future.
