Tidbits From Town Departments

Highway Department:

Brush Pickup: Now that Spring has sprung; the Department once again will begin their brush pickups. Brush is collected from April through



November.

Brush should be placed street side by 6:30am on Mondays. Piles should be no more than 3 feet long, with no limbs over 10" in diameter and the cut ends facing the road in a single row. The Department will not pick up any stumps, root balls, yard waste or clippings. Also, no lot clearings or contractor generated waste will be picked up.

Highway crews will pick up for properties on the North side of Town {from Broadway} during the first full week of the month and on the south side of Town {from Broadway} on the third week of the month. For questions, contact Highway Superintendent Bill Rogers at 937-7336.
