Motion for expenses from treasury: By Darlene Dahl for \$50 to use for prizes for card bingo after the Thanksgiving luncheon, Seconded by Dorothy Szrama. All in favor - none opposed - motion carried. Motion by Darlene Dahl for up to \$35 for the annual President's award. Seconded by Joe Dahl. All in favor – none opposed – motion carried. As a note: the Town will reimburse our Treasury up to \$200 to expend on the Christmas luncheon – for centerpieces and/or favors.

Vice President, Shirley Heitzman, read a thank you from the Alden/Marilla Food Pantry.

Sunshine Club, Fannie reported: Fannie absent, nothing to report.

Bingo – Betty reported all going well. Reiterated that Bingo is on Tuesdays.
