

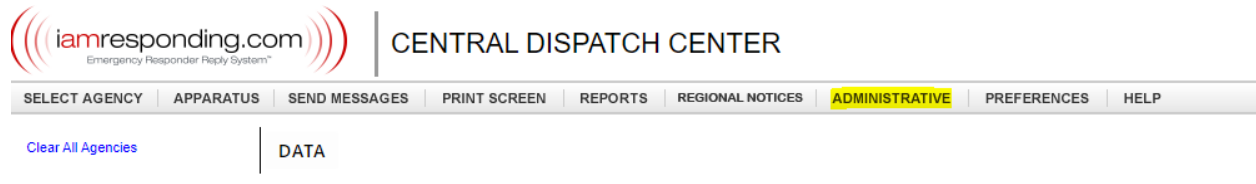


New Feature Notice: Non-Emergent Regional Notices

This is the new ability for dispatch centers to communicate with any IaR subscribers linked to that dispatch center via a new information tile that displays on the on the user's IaR display screens and IaR apps ("Regional Notices").

Here's an overview of this:

On the IaR dispatch screens, when you log in as an administrator, you see the "Administrative" tab:



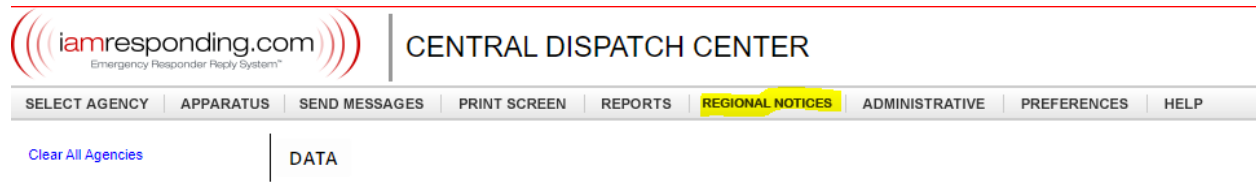
Clicking on that gives a list of currently authorized users, and their current permissions. There is a new permission called "Permitted to edit regional notices?"

Update or delete an existing member of the current Dispatch Center:

A dispatcher needs that permission to use this feature.

All dispatchers with credentials to access an IaR dispatch screen will see a new menu item called Regional Notices:



That opens a screen that looks like this, which is a rich text editing box in which they can enter anything (including images), and format colors, sizes, font, tables, etc (the "Hospital Status table below is just an example):

That is the new tile that will display regional notices from dispatch.

When you add that tile, if the agency is linked to more than one dispatch center, the user has to also click the gear symbol here:
