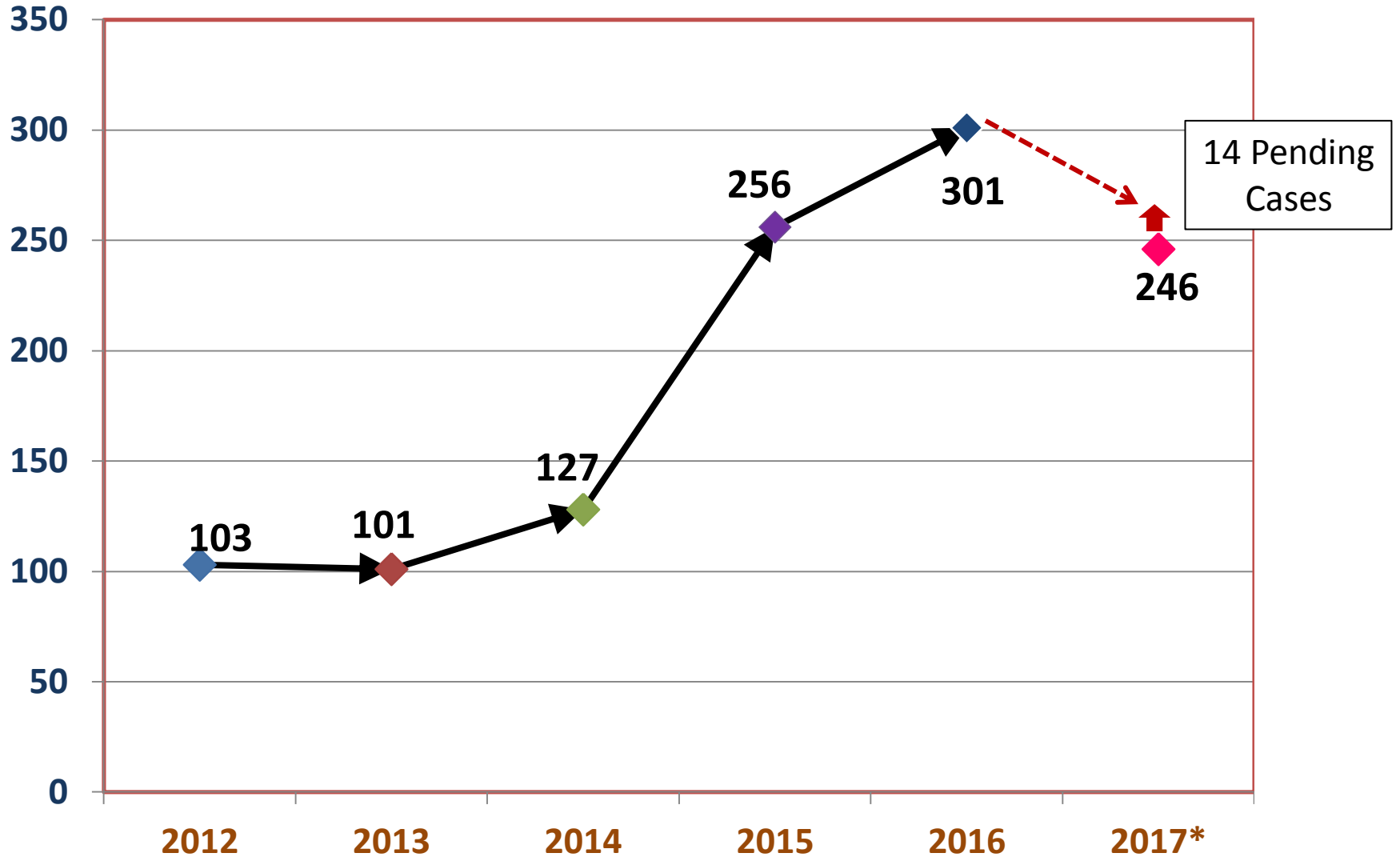

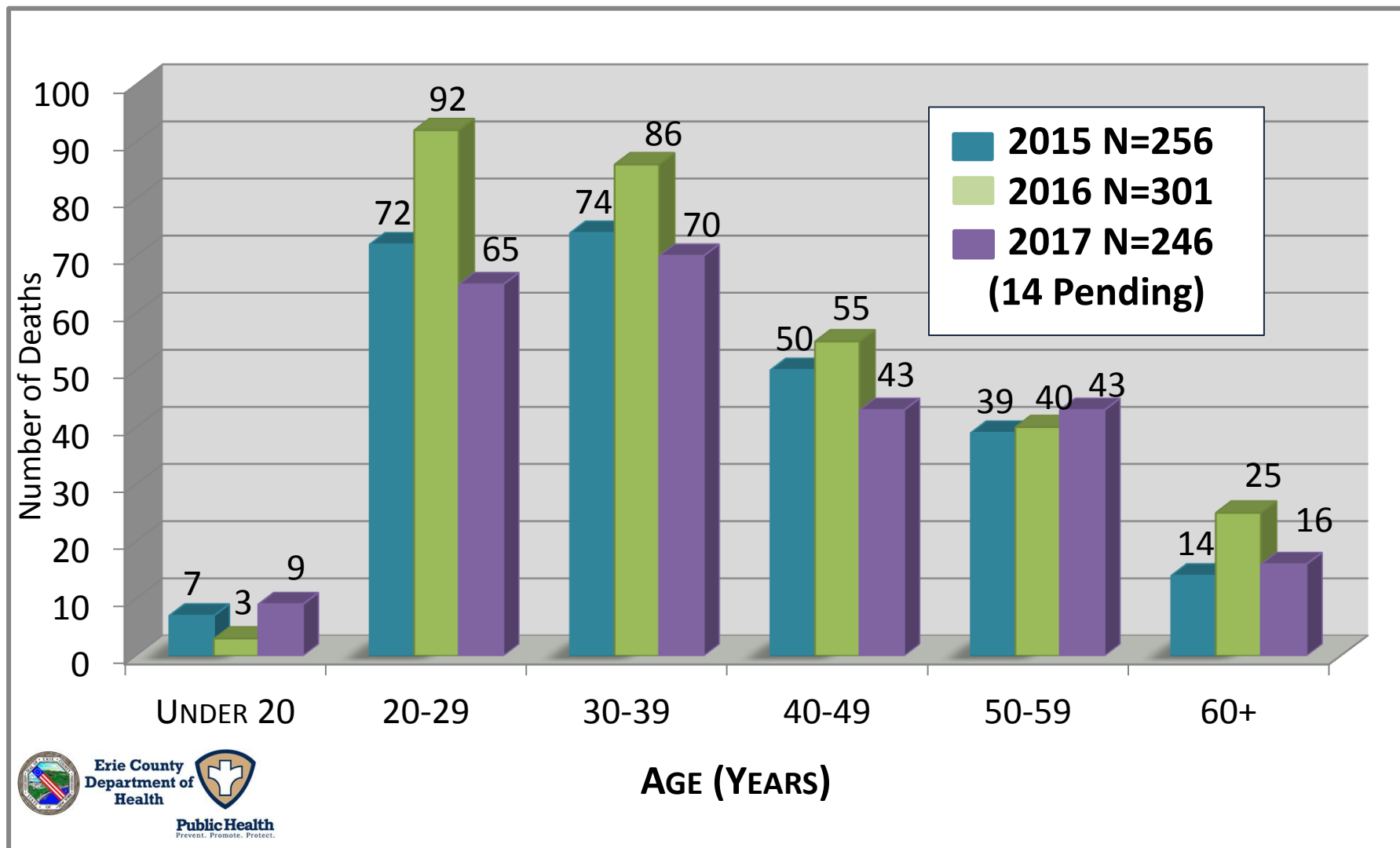

2015 – 2017* ERIE COUNTY OPIOID DEATHS BY AGE AND YEAR



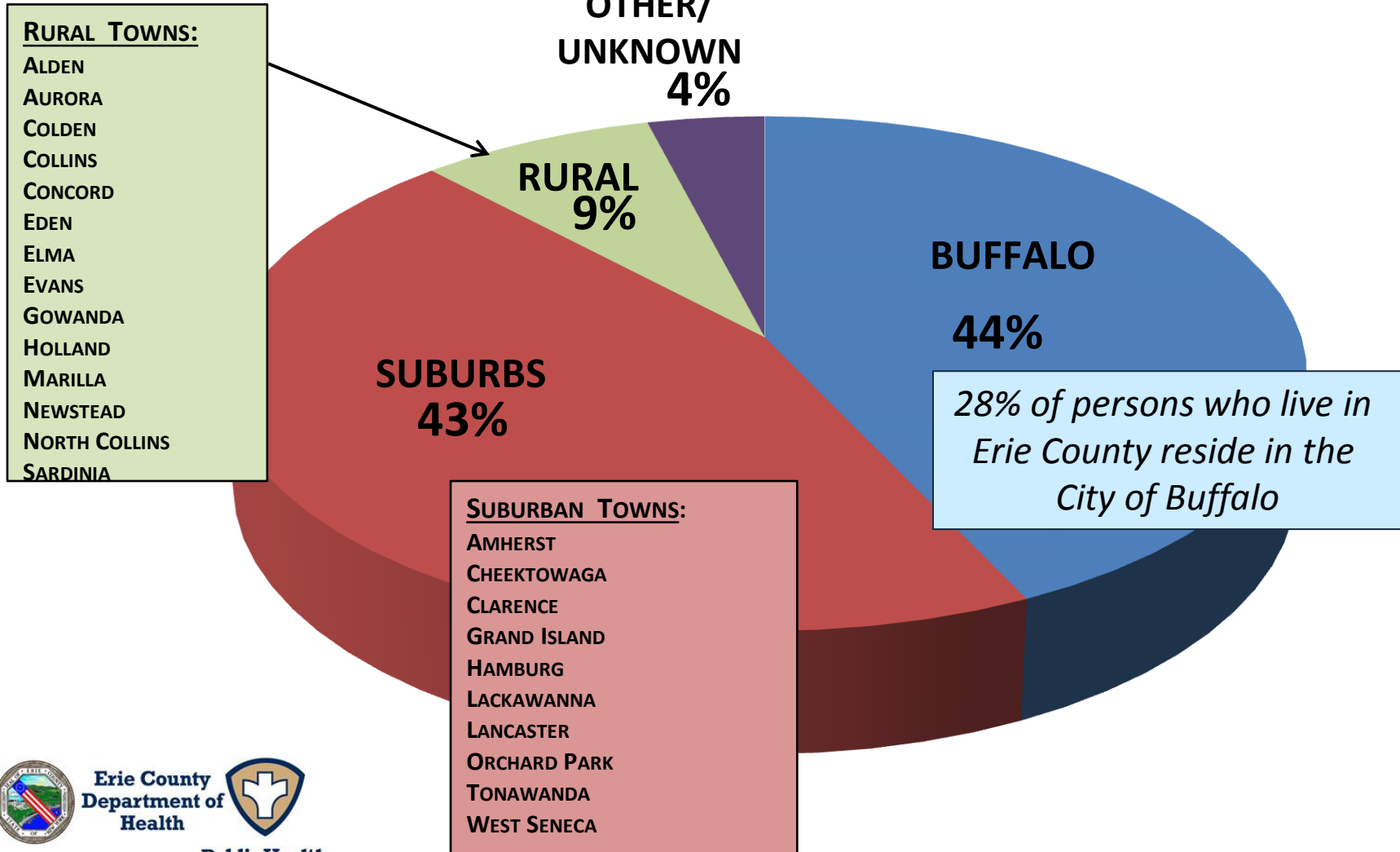

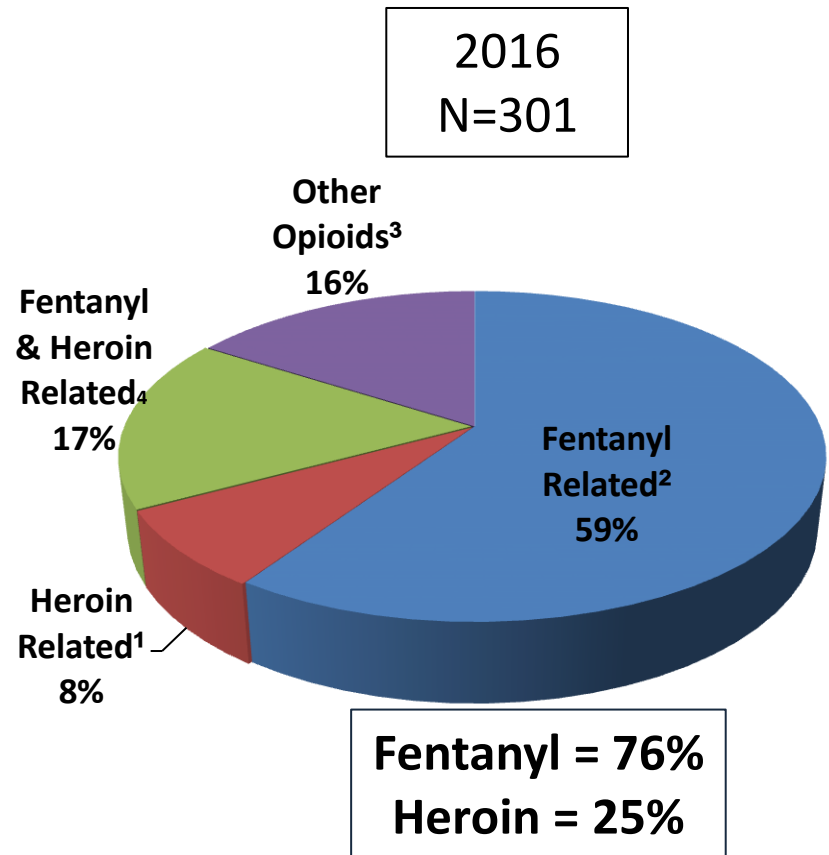
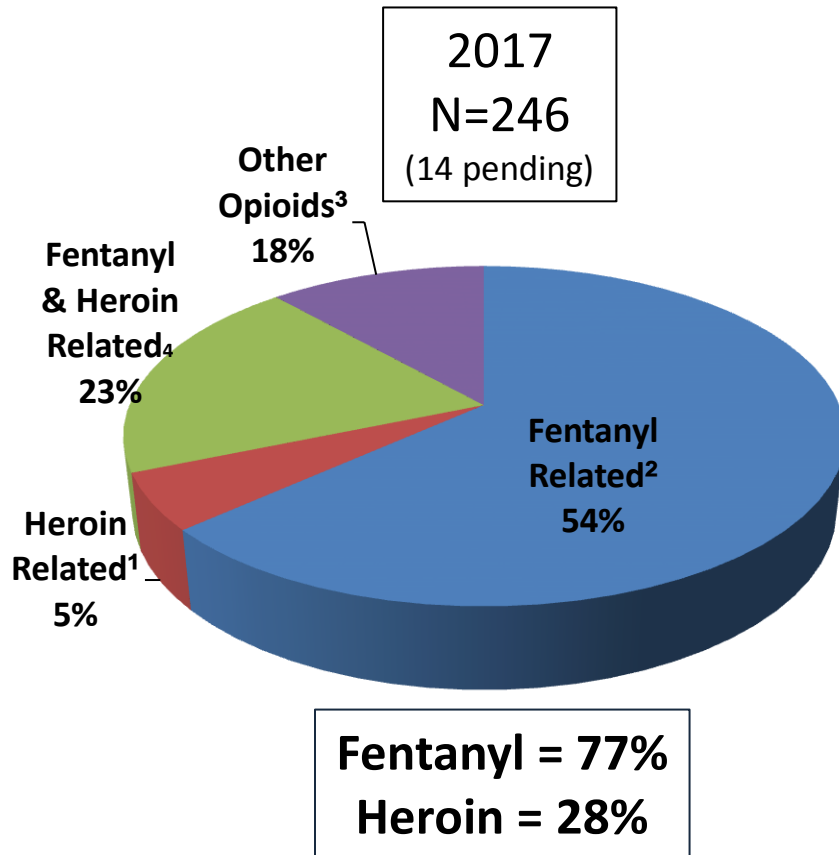


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2016 AND 2017* ERIE COUNTY OPIOID RELATED DEATHS BY TYPE OF OPIOID
