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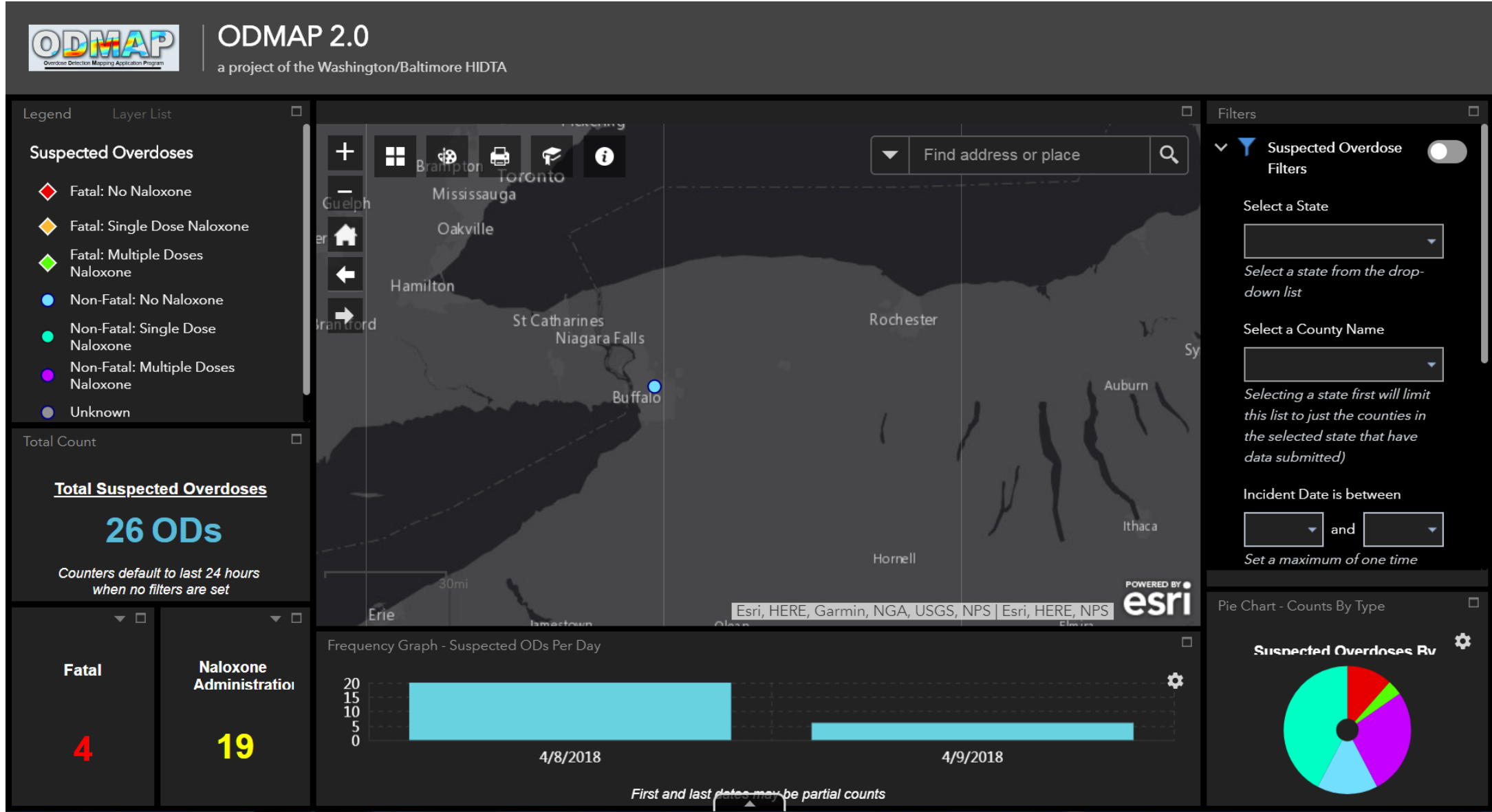


Task Force Mission:

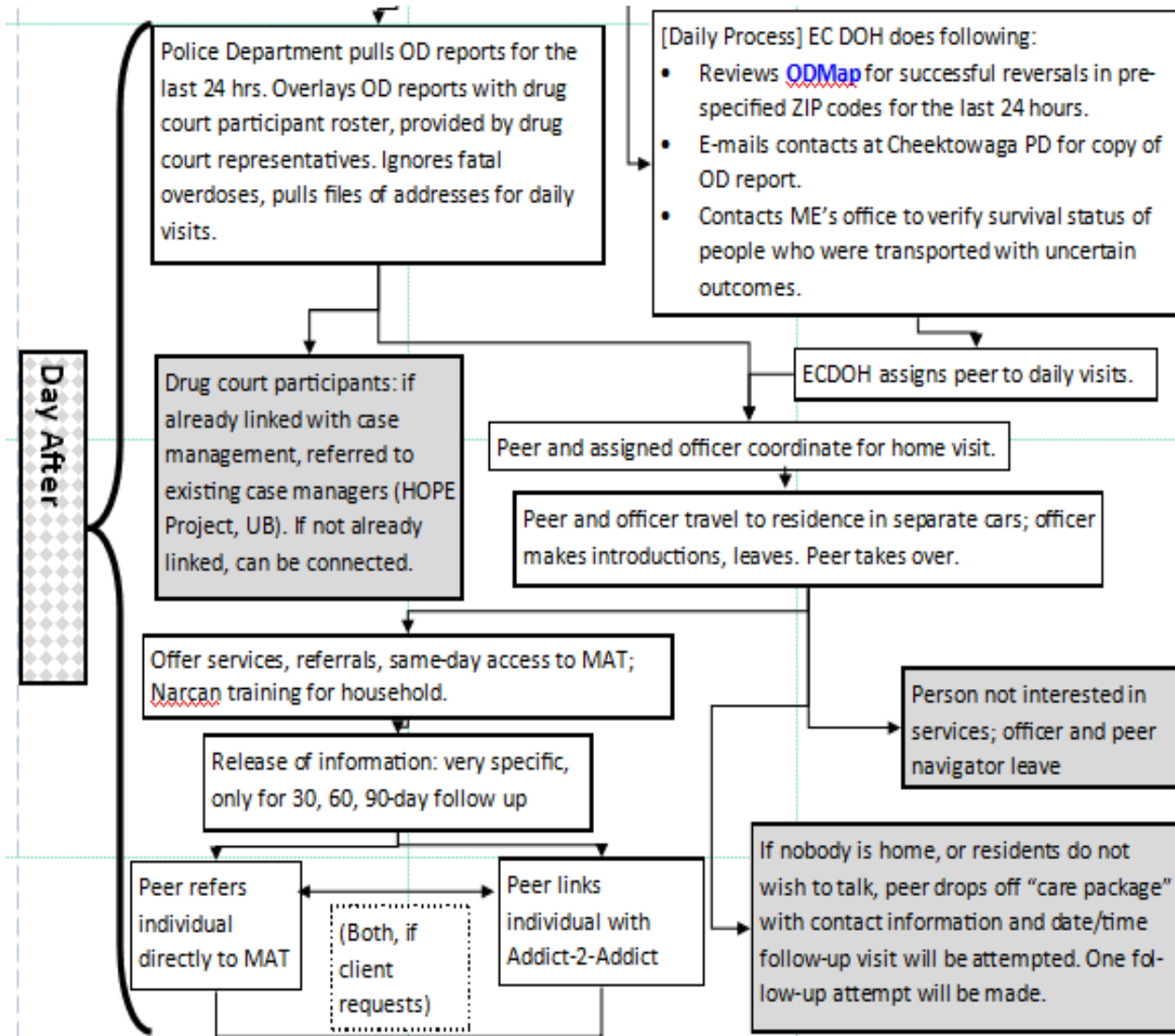
Immediate Response to Overdoses

Follow-up

ECDOH does follow-up with client: 30 days, 60 days, 90 days. Reconnects to care if necessary and client is willing.

ECDOH creates monthly report with de-identified data and numbers of engagement to care





Outcomes to Date



- September 1, 2017 – May 1, 2018
- 37 clients total identified through ODMAP after overdose and direct referrals from law enforcement officers in the Town of Cheektowaga, NY
- 25 individuals identified after overdose using ODMAP
- 12 individuals identified through direct referral from law enforcement when identified through associated crimes

Outcomes to Date



- 19 in treatment at the 60 day follow up point
 - Treatment breakdown as follows:
 - Methadone – 9
 - Suboxone – 8
 - Inpatient detox – 1
 - Inpatient rehab – 1
- 1 in jail on warrant pick up
- 8 flat out refused treatment offers, we will continue to follow up with them every 30 days
- 2 actively working with peer to identify program to meet individual needs
 - work schedule, school schedule
- 7 are working with the peer currently, have not turned down treatment but are not yet ready to commit
