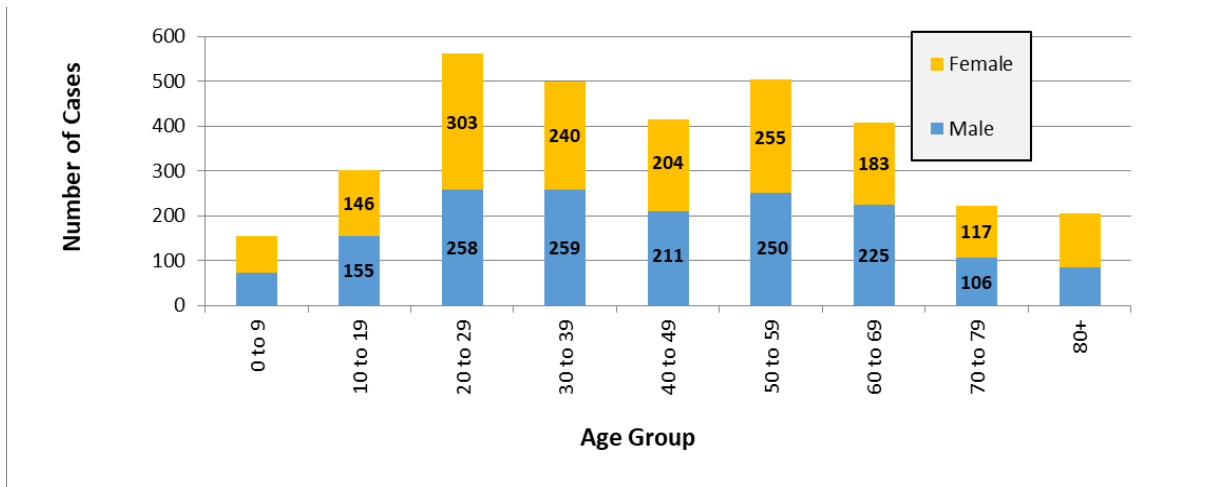


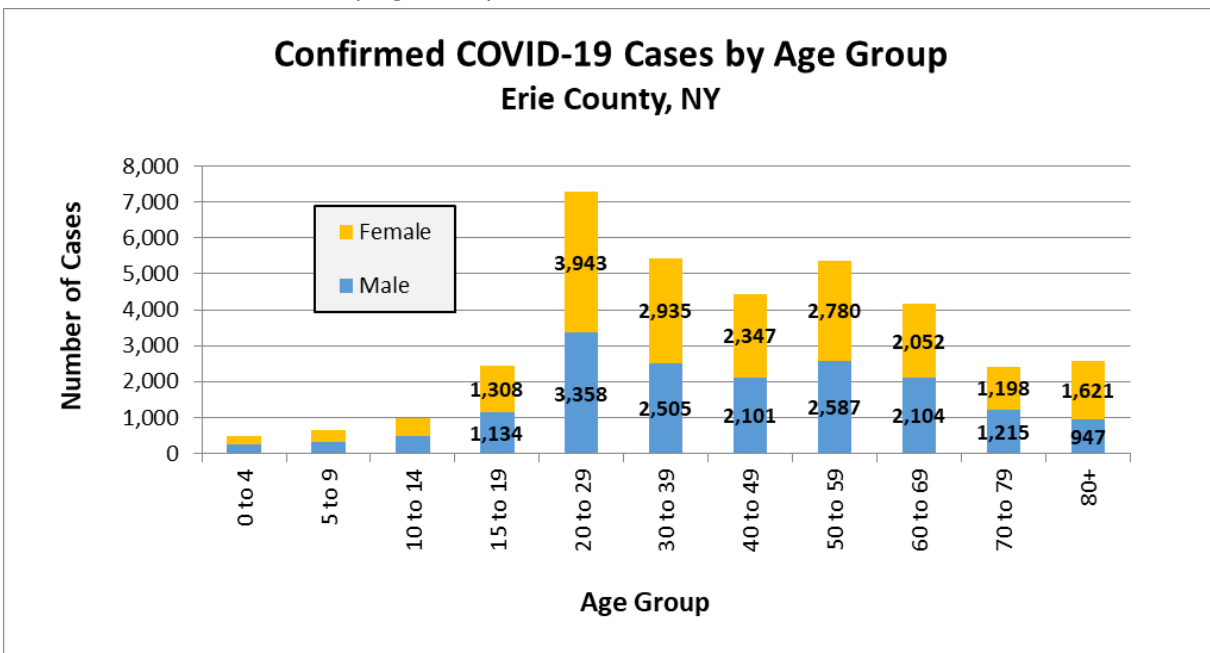
Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender

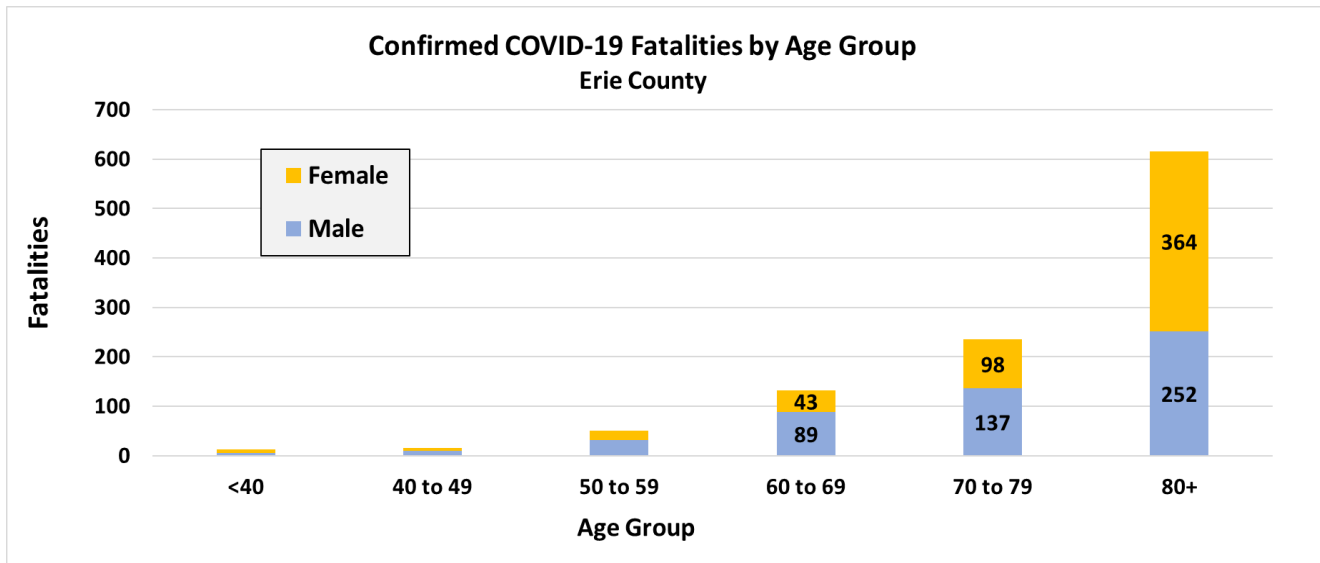
