

COUNTY OF ERIE

LOCAL LAW No. 1 -1961

A local law amending "an act to provide for the establishment of a system of highways in the county of Erie to be known as the greater motorways system of highways of the county of Erie, chapter seven hundred eighteen of the laws of nineteen hundred twenty-eight, as amended by chapter seven hundred ten of the laws of nineteen hundred forty-three."

Became a law May 17, 1961 with the approval of the County Executive. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Erie. Filed in the office of the secretary of state May 31, 1961.

*Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Erie as follows:*

Section 1. Sections three, seventeen and eighteen of An Act to provide for the establishment of a system of highways in the county of Erie to be known as the greater motorways system of highways of the county of Erie, chapter seven hundred eighteen of the laws of nineteen hundred twenty-eight, as amended by chapter seven hundred ten of the laws of nineteen hundred forty-three, are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 3. Whenever the board of supervisors shall deem it for the public interest to acquire a parcel or parcels of land for the construction or improvement of such highway, said board of supervisors shall first cause a map of the proposed improvement to be prepared by the commissioner of public works, which map shall distinctly indicate the several parcels to be acquired, the names of the owners if known, and the dimensions and bounds of each of such parcels. Such map shall be filed in the office of the county clerk. Thereupon the board of supervisors shall cause to be published once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper published in the county a notice of the filing of such map and a statement that it is the intention of said board of supervisors to construct such highway. An affidavit of the publication of such notice shall be filed in the office of the clerk of the board of supervisors upon the completion of said publication. The board of supervisors of the county, its agents, engineers and surveyors, and such other persons as may be necessary to enable it to perform its duties under this act, are hereby authorized to enter upon any real property for the purpose of making surveys, examinations or investigations, and of preparing maps or for such other purposes as may be necessary in the performance of its duties under this act.

§ 17. Upon the recommendation of the commissioner of public works, the board of supervisors of Erie County may remove a road, or a part of a road, from the greater motorways system of highways in the county of Erie. Upon the adoption of the resolution therefor by the board of supervisors the map of the greater motorways system of highways of Erie county shall be amended so as to eliminate said road, or part of said road, from the map of the greater motorways system of highways of Erie County, and said road, or part of said road, shall thereupon revert to the town or towns, village or villages, or city or cities wherein said road, or part of said road, is situated, and thereafter shall be maintained by said town or towns, village or villages, or city or cities, in the same manner as other town highways or village streets or city streets are maintained.

Notice and map of such removal from the greater motorways system of Erie County of such road or part thereof shall be filed by the commissioner of public works in the office of the county clerk and with the clerk of the governing board of such town or towns, village or villages, city or cities, wherein said road or part thereof is situated.

§ 18. This act shall take effect immediately.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
