Local Law No. 7 of the year 19 89

A local law amending local law no. 6-1980 and local law no. 7-1988 to regulate and prohibit the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the county park system.

Be it enacted by the ERIE COUNTY LEGISLATURE of the

Section 1. Section 14 of Local Law No. 6-1980 adopted by the Erie County Legislature on May 15, 1980, and signed by the Erie County Executive on June 6, 1980, and as amended by local Law No. 7-1988, adding a new subdivision (c), is hereby amended to read as follows:

(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivisions (a) and (b), the consumption of beer, ale or wine shall be prohibited at Como Park during the months of September through June, inclusive, and the consumption of beer, ale or wine shall be prohibited at all other parks in the county system from October 1 through, but not including Memorial Day weekend. At all other times, the Commissioner shall issue rules and regulations pursuant to section 21 which shall effectuate a procedure for the orderly consumption of beer, ale and wine in all county parks. These regulations shall regulate the areas of consumption within Como Park and shall prohibit consumption within one thousand (1000) feet of tennis courts and Friendship Center.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
