**SUMMARY**

This resolution is seeking your honorable body's authorization for the County Executive to enter into an Agreement Amendment for design services with the following Architectural/Engineering firms:

DiDonato Engineering – Electrical service vault repairs

Watts Architecture & Engineering – Asbestos abatement project for removal of the carpeting, vinyl tile and mastic, at the meeting rooms on the north and south side of the facility.

BHNT Architects – Replacement of the existing flooring in the Ballroom.

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

Funds for the project are currently available from the approved and adopted 2010 and 2011 County Budgets. The SAP project accounts are delineated as such:

A.21004 – 2010- Buffalo Niagara Convention Center Rehabilitation	\$16,500.00
A.11003 - 2011- Countywide Code and Environmental Compliance	<u>\$29,100.00</u>
	\$45,600.00

**REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION**

These improvements will correct various health and safety issues at the Buffalo Niagara Convention Center. The County has been notified by National Grid that major structural deficiencies exist in the sidewalk vaults and the walls are crumbling. If not immediately corrected, National Grid may have to turn off the building's power.

The Ballroom flooring is continuously heaving and causing tripping problems. One area had to be temporarily corrected prior to the 2012 Auto and Home shows. Correcting the problem will eliminate possible law suits against the County.

The carpet is being replaced in the Meeting Rooms on the north and south ends of the first floor. The removal of the existing carpet and original VCT floor tile revealed mastic that contains ACM materials which must be abated.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Consultant will prepare plans and specifications in accordance with all codes and regulations to correct these deficiencies. All work must be performed this summer during the lowest schedule of Convention Center use.

### **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**


Health and safety issues will not be corrected. The County could be sued from tripping hazards and unsafe conditions.

### **STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL**

The County Executive will enter into an Agreement Amendment with the Architectural/Engineering firms of DiDonato Engineering, Watts Architectural & Engineering, and BHNT Architects for providing Architectural/Engineering services to provide the design and construction documents so work can commence.

### **COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW**

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting authorization from your honorable body to issue an Agreement Amendment to DiDonato Engineering for electrical service vault repairs; Watts Architecture & Engineering for the asbestos abatement project for removal of the carpeting, vinyl tile and mastic in the meeting rooms on the north and south side of the facility; and BHNT Architects for the replacement of the existing flooring in the Ballroom; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is authorized to issue an Agreement Amendment to the following architectural/engineering firms for providing professional design and construction document services for the Buffalo Niagara Convention Center, health and safety issues, including reimbursement as follows:

<u>Watts Architectural &amp; Engineering</u> – Asbestos Abatement project for removal of carpeting, vinyl tile and mastic and the meeting rooms on the north and south side of the facility	\$10,600.00
<u>BHNT Architects</u> – replacement of the existing flooring in the Ballroom;	<u>\$16,500.00</u>
For a total amount not to exceed; and be it further	\$45,600.00
