

SUMMARY

This resolution seeks authorization to award engineering services for the design and the rehabilitation of Evans Center Eden Road (CR 221), Beach Rd (CR 32)/Town of Evans to DiDonato Associates, as engineering design consultants.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The funding available is SAP B.21001 – 2010 Capital Overlay Program.

REASONS FOR RECOMENDATION

Evans Center Eden Road/Beach Road is a main thoroughfare with a NYS Thruway Exit and is a highly traveled road. The deteriorating condition of the road has made it difficult for the traveling public. The road has been evaluated by Cornell Road program, associated with Cornell University, and it is recommended the sub-base material be removed and the road reconstructed. Failure to address the conditions of the road will cause continuing deteriorating road conditions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For the past several years the County has evaluated this road and recently partnered with Cornell Roads program to study the road in working on a solution for the stability problems associated with the sub-base of the road. The County is, therefore, undertaking the current project to build upon the work done by Cornell and resolve the long-standing stability and roadway restriction issues on Evans Center Eden Road/Beach Road.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION


The current conditions on Evans Center Eden Road/Beach Road will continue negatively impacting public mobility and safety.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will enter into an Agreement with the engineering firm of DiDonato Associates for providing Architectural/Engineering Services to provide the design and construction documents so work can commence.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, when Eden-Evans Center Road and Beach Road was reconstructed about 40 years ago, slag was used as a sub-base material which at the time, it was thought that slag was an acceptable material for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, long stretches of this road have been heaving in the winter months making the road difficult to drive in those months due to the wicking of water in the sub-base; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Department of Public Works has tried several solutions to mitigate the heaving with no success; and

WHEREAS, the only solution is to fully remove the slag sub-base and replace it with gravel material and new pavement; and

WHEREAS, before construction can commence, these roads are in need of design; and

WHEREAS, funds exist in SAP Project number B.21001 (2010 Capital Overlay Program) for work on Eden-Evans Center Road (CR 221)/Beach Road (CR32); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to use these funds to begin design work on this roadway; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature authorizes the County Executive to enter into a contract for engineering services for the design of the rehabilitation of Eden-Evans Center Road (CR 221) and Beach Road (CR32), in the Town of Evans with DiDonato Associates for an amount not to exceed \$180,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, SAP Project B.21001, Capital Overlay Program, will be utilized to perform the necessary study and design of the project; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature forward three (3) certified copies of this resolution to the Department of Public Works, Office of the Commissioner, and one copy each to the Office of the County Executive, the Division of Budget and Management, and the Office of the Comptroller.


