A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED BY LEGISLATORS GRANT & HOGUES

RE: Appointment/Reappointments to the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board

WHEREAS, the Erie County Legislature approved INTRO 16-4 (2010) establishing the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board providing for the appointment of thirteen (13) voting members, and with the subsequent approval of INTRO 4-4 (2011), the Community Corrections Advisory Board was expanded to include fifteen (15) voting members; and

WHEREAS, members of the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board are appointed by the Erie County Legislature upon the recommendation of community stakeholders, and the terms of three board members have expired; and

WHEREAS, of the three, one member is to be recommended by a recognized organization working on behalf of prisoners' right, one member is to be recommended by the Erie County Executive, and one member is to be recommended by the Erie County Commissioner of Health; and

WHEREAS, the community organization Prisoners Are People Too! has submitted the recommendation to reappoint Board Member Rev. Eugene Pierce, County Executive Poloncarz has submitted the recommendation to appoint Joseph Cercone, and Erie County Health Commissioner Burstein has submitted the recommendation to reappoint Board Member Michael Kubik, and all three are eligible to serve three-year terms to expire on February 15, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that effective immediately, the Erie County Legislature does hereby appoint/reappoint the following named individuals to serve as members of the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board for terms that will expire on February 15, 2015:
