SUMMARY

Request adoption of resolution to authorize the County Executive to award and enter into an agreement with the responsible low bidder for the rehabilitation of Beach Road and Eden Evans Center Road Project once bids are taken on May 31, 2012 and the lowest responsible bidder is determined, establish a construction contingency, and execute a contract with project engineers DiDonato Associates for construction inspection and services during construction.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The total funds available for the construction phase of this project is currently \$3,359,516.59
\$428,769.63 is available in SAP B.21001 – 2010 Capital Overlay
\$20,164.56 is available in SAP B.11001.2 – 2011 Capital Overlay
\$557,582.40 is available in SAP B.11005 – 2011 Various County Roads
\$2,000,000.00 is available in B.12007 – 2012 Preservation of Roads – Construction
\$353,000.00 is available in B.12015 - 2012 Capital Overlay Program.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

Due to the limited construction season, it is necessary that this approval be granted, so that the contract can be awarded to allow the contractor to begin construction as soon as possible.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In order not to delay the project, it is recommended the County Executive be authorized to execute an agreement with responsible low bidder, establish the construction contingency and execute a contract with project engineers DiDonato Associates once bids are taken and analyzed.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION


The construction phase of the Project will not be fully implemented in a timely manner and therefore, not completed. The road will continue to deteriorate and become an increasing hazard to the driving public.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The lowest responsible bidder will be determined by the Department of Public Works, a contract will be awarded, the County Executive will execute the construction contract, establish a construction contingency, and execute the contract with project engineers DiDonato Associates. Construction will begin as soon as possible depending on the weather and the availability of materials. The Department of Public Works will notify the Legislature, for information only, the bid results and contract awardee.
