SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works, in response to the New York State Department of Energy Conservation Dam Hazard Determinations, recommends Bergmann Associates, an approved provider of engineering services via Comm. 14E-19 of July 17, 2008, as best suited to complete this project.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The amount of fee is not to exceed \$360,000.00 (Business Area 123, Fund 420, SAP Project B.12009) and will be negotiated by the Department of Public Works with Bergmann Associates, the selected consultant, and an appropriate contract being issued to the firm.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The utilization of Dam Safety, Inspection and Design Engineering Services agreement will permit the Department of Public Works to proceed with the dam inspections and minor repair projects, if necessary, in a very timely, cost-effective manner.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Separate agreements for each and every small project become difficult to manage and track through the system. By combining the Dam Inspections and unforeseen small projects that may be necessary from information gained during the inspections into one General Engineering Service agreement, efficiency will be increased with resultant savings in time and funds.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION


If the Dam Safety, Inspection and Design Engineering Services agreement is not processed, the traveling public and public, in general, may be in danger from uninspected dams that are subject to possible damage or complete collapse depending upon their unknown condition.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Upon receiving the Erie County Legislature's approval, agreements will be prepared and executed with the firm selected. Once the agreement is executed, Dam Safety, Inspection and possible design work will begin immediately thereafter.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized capital project for which there will be sufficient funding once the 2012 bonds are sold. This project is included in the agreed upon list of 2012 projects to advance.
