SUMMARY

The Commissioner of Public Works advertised services for the purpose of selecting one or more firms to provide environmental consulting services on various County projects. After reviewing the submittals received, firms were selected to provide said consulting services. The Commissioner of Public Works is, therefore, recommending that the Erie County Legislature authorize the County Executive to enter into a contract with each of the selected firms.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for the project are currently available from the approved and adopted 2012 County Budget, SAP Project A.12003 – 2012 – County Wide Code & Environmental Compliance.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

Each of the firms selected has submitted evidence that they have the necessary expertise, experience and manpower to provide the necessary environmental consulting services.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The environmental consulting services necessary include asbestos related air monitoring, surveys, and bulk sampling on various County projects. These services are necessary in order to implement new asbestos abatement programs and to continue previously initiated asbestos abatement programs.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

If the consulting contracts are not approved, a delay will be experienced in initiating new asbestos abatement programs, as well as bring to a halt previously established programs.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Upon legislative approval, contracts will be prepared and executed with each of the selection firms with the necessary consulting services being provided shortly thereafter.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

For proposed 2012 bonds, the proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized capital project for which there will be sufficient funding once the 2012 bonds are sold. This project is included in the agreed upon list of 2012 projects to advance.
