Re: Operation IMPACT IX Grant Immediate Consideration Requested

I. Summary of Recommended Action

The proposed resolution and accompanying memorandum request authorization to reallocate funds and create a new position in the Operation IMPACT IX Grant for the 2012 to 2013 grant year, in accordance with the final approved grantor contract. We are requesting the deletion of one Assistant District Attorney III, JG 14, and the creation of an Assistant District Attorney V, JG 16.

II. <u>Fiscal Implications of Proposal</u>

Funds in the approved 2012 Eric County Operation IMPACT Grant Budget are being reallocated to properly reflect the increased spending levels approved by the grantor. There will be no impact to county tax dollars.

III. Reason for Recommendation and Background of Proposal

This recommendation will allow the Operation IMPACT Grant amounts as listed in the 2012 Budget Book B to be realigned with the final grantor approved appropriation levels. Program amounts as listed in the 2012 Budget Book B for the Operation IMPACT grant were provided approximately one year prior to receiving a fully executed contract from the grantor. Consequently, the actual grant award differs from the approved appropriation levels. Among other positions, the IMPACT grant has funded four Assistant District Attorney III (JG14) positions for a number of years. As a result of our grant application, DCJS has replaced one of those ADA IIIs with increased funding to allow for a Senior Impact ADA, funded at the level of an Assistant District Attorney V, JG16.

The Senior Assistant District Attorney under Operation IMPACT will prosecute higher level and higher profile felony cases meeting the IMPACT criteria. The Senior ADA will act as the gang and gun liaison to Operation IMPACT, attending the monthly IMPACT meetings. S/he will be responsible for keeping in contact with officers and detectives on the street to gain knowledge of Buffalo's gang population. The Senior ADA will also maintain a full caseload, utilizing a vertical prosecution strategy. Recognizing the need to further enhance the collaboration between law enforcement, intelligence and prosecution, the DA's Office is proposing a change to the IMPACT team by creating the position of Senior IMPACT ADA who would act as a liaison to the law enforcement and intelligence components of the IMPACT partnership. This position would keep abreast of all IMPACT priority areas in addition to gang and gun activity in the City of Buffalo. In addition, this position would handle more serious felony level crimes and act as a resource to three junior ADA's.

IV. Consequences of Negative Action

Failure to approve this request could result in the diminished effect of the Operation IMPACT Grant on the residents of Erie County; grant funds will not be accurately recorded since actual grant award allocations differ from previously approved appropriations. If grant objectives and tasks are not met, the funding for eight employees will be lost.

V. <u>Steps Following Approval of Measure</u> The District Attorney's Office will work with the Division of Budget and Finance to implement this proposal.

RESOLVED, that effective July 1, 2012, authorization is hereby provided to create one position of Assistant District Attorney V in the District Attorney's Operation IMPACT Grant (B-100 #6910) and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does hereby provide authorization to reallocate funds within the Operation IMPACT Grant to match authorized state funding levels, to be adjusted as follows:
