SUMMARY

The Erie County Legislature is requested to receive and file this communication, which pertains to the Department's approval of Work Order URS-8 with URS Corporation for consultant services in the amount of \$24,790.07.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no fiscal implications to the County's General Fund. The cost of the consultant work covered by this communication will be paid by Bond Account No. C.00072 of ECSD No.4.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

URS will provide a value engineering/evaluation report on the construction documents for the Aurora North Pumping Station Elimination Project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 29, 2007, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution authorizing Service Agreements with five (5) different engineering firms. As a condition of the award, the Legislature required the Division of Sewerage Management to notify the Legislature of each Work Order by the Division of Sewerage Management.

The Service Agreements were approved to expedite solutions to engineering and construction problems on small projects or to handle emergency situations. For example, on some projects there is insufficient time or it is economically impractical to prepare an individual Request for Proposal. Examples of such instances would be emergency work or small cost projects.

Accordingly, the Department has approved Work Order URS-8 with URS Corporation in the amount of \$24,790.07 to provide a value engineering/evaluation report for the design documents associated with the Aurora North Pumping Station Elimination Project.

Work Order URS - 8

Scope of Services

In general, URS Corporation - New York (URS) will perform a review of the Engineer's Report and Construction Documents prepared by the Erie County Department of Environment & Planning, Division of Sewerage Management (DEP) for the above referenced project.

More specifically URS will:

1. Review and become familiar with the existing Engineer's Report, Construction Drawings and Specifications.
2. Review the constructability and completeness of the following documents:
 - a. Engineer's Report, dated April 2012
 - b. Construction Drawings, dated May 2012 (14 sheets)
 - c. Specifications and Contract Documents, dated May 2012, including Addendums No. 1 & 2.
 - d. Subsurface Investigation and Geotechnical Report prepared by Empire Geo-Services, Inc., dated September 2011 (Appendix C of the Specifications).
3. Review the following Construction Cost Estimates:
 - a. Engineer's Report; Alternates 1, 2 & 3.
 - b. Final Engineer's Estimate
4. Review the Bid Tabulation and contact bidders to discuss their prices and items in the design that they felt added increased risk and cost to their construction price.
5. Compare cost estimates and bid prices with recent similar projects.
6. Review costs, details and options for boring and jacking or directional drilling of the sewer pipe. Engage in-house drilling expertise from other offices and contact local drilling contractors for input.

7. Review details, requirements and options of rock blasting, including allowable velocities.
8. Review de-watering requirements and options.
9. Prepare a construction cost estimate for a potential Phase 1 for the project.
Phase 1 will consist of new sewer from the Borden Road intersection with Losson Road, along Losson Road to William Street passed the Wal Mart driveway, then south across William Street to the south right-of-way line of William Street.
10. Prepare an Evaluation Report detailing our findings, opinions and recommendations concerning Items No. 1 through 8 detailed above.
11. Provide six (6) copies of the report to DEP.
12. Meet with representatives of DEP to review the report.

Assumptions:

1. Engineer's Report – assume pipe hydraulics as presented is correct; unless URS notices a discrepancy.
2. Pipe Route – to remain unchanged.
3. Material Quantities used for bidding are assumed correct; unless URS notices a discrepancy.
