## **MEMORANDUM**

**TO:** Erie County Legislature  
**FROM:** Robert W. Keating, Director of Budget and Management  
**RE:** Closure of Inactive Capital Projects  
**DATE:** September 24, 2012

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### **SUMMARY**

The attached resolution authorizes the closure of 54 inactive capital projects and to transfer the balance in those accounts to Fund 310 Debt Service to effectuate the closure of 10 inactive, underfunded capital projects from prior years.

### **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

The resolution requires no appropriations and has no additional costs in the 2012 Budget. Inactive capital accounts with available balances will be closed, their debt service defeased and the balance used to close underfunded capital projects.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Numerous capital projects have been inactive for many years and which retain available balances. After consulting with the Department of Public Works and the Erie County Comptroller's Office, the Division of Budget and Management seeks to close these projects, pay-off their debt service (if any still remains) and transfer the remaining balance to close-out other underfunded capital projects.

### **CONSEQUENCES OF A NEGATIVE ACTION**

If authorization is not granted, the capital projects will remain inactive with available balances and underfunded projects will continue to show negative balances requiring future clean-up actions.

### **STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL**

The Division of Budget and Management will work with the Office of Comptroller to close the inactive capital projects.

**A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED BY  
DIVISION OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Division of Budget and Management have been reviewing capital projects and have identified a number of projects where work has been completed and are ready to wholly or partially close; and

WHEREAS, based on a review by the Division of Budget and Management and the Comptroller's Office, a balance totaling \$1,082,420.09 for 2012 is available for closing; and

WHEREAS, all of the projects have outstanding principal and interest payments and New York State Local Finance Law requires utilization of remaining project balances for the payment of the outstanding principal and interest related to these capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Budget and Management and Comptroller's Office have identified ten capital projects which are eligible to be closed, but which maintain negative balances reflecting that they were underfunded in prior years; and

WHEREAS, prior to closing, it is necessary to transfer \$1,055,947.95 to close these underfunded projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that authorization is hereby provided to wholly or partially close the following 54 capital projects in Funds 420, 410, 480 and 511 and to transfer available funds to Fund 310 Debt Service, to be utilized to assist in the payment of the outstanding principal and interest payments related to these capital projects in 2012 and to transfer \$1,055,947.95 of the balance to under-funded prior year accounts to enable their closure:
