The members of the Erie County Community Corrections Advisory Board believe that the prisoners at the Erie County Holding Center should have access to a full-time Chaplain. They agree with Common Council Member Reverend Darius G. Pridgen that, the presence of a Chaplain can reduce the incidence of recidivism. Enclosed is a copy of a letter from Rev. Pridgen, in which he explains why the presence of a full-time Chaplain is beneficial to the prisoners and the community.

This letter serves as a humble request for a full time Chaplain to the Erie County Holding Center and Correctional Facility.

The presence of religious programming in these facilities is tied to the rehabilitation of offenders. Religion is a more relatable form of counseling for prisoners that are familiar with the doctrine, and those who may not typically gravitate towards it may as a result of a Chaplain's established rapport. The Chaplain becomes pastor to the inmates as well as their teacher in spiritual matters. His mission, like that of the church includes regeneration, spiritual development and hope.

I believe the return of a prison Chaplain will assist individuals as they work to reenter society, their self-esteem will increase and repeated or habitual relapse in criminal matters will decrease.
