SUMMARY

This resolution is requesting authorization for the County Executive to enter into an Agreement Amendment with the Architectural firm of Stievater Associates for providing Architectural / Engineering services to provide an evaluation report for the Wendt Beach Mansion deterioration.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for the project are currently available from the 2012, as amended capital budget, SAP Project A.12007 – 2012 Countywide Parks Improvements and Equipment.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The building has been closed for some six (6) to seven (7) years. An Architectural/Engineering evaluation report is required to determine the extent of damage to preserve the historical building.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Wendt Mansion is located on the lake at Wendt Beach Park and has become a frequent target of vandals. The mansion is a historical building as part of the original Margaret Wendt Summer Home.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The building will continue to be vandalized and deteriorate to the point where the historic building will need to be demolished.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will enter into an agreement with the architectural firm of Stievater Associates for providing architectural/engineering services to provide an evaluation report for the Wendt Beach Mansion.

COMPTROLLER'S REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.
