WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, I declared a State of Emergency within the County of Erie; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of the State of New York issued Executive Order Number 202, declaring a State Disaster Emergency for the entire State of New York; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2020, I issued a local emergency order which suspended and modified Section 2511 of the Erie County Charter to the extent necessary to extend the time period for submission of a written proposal of remedies to overcome a deficit declared under the Erie County Charter; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2020, I extended such local emergency order for a period of five days; and

WHEREAS, the County of Erie and the State of New York remain in a state of emergency; and

LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, I declared a State of Emergency within the County of Erie; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of the State of New York issued Executive Order Number 202, declaring a State Disaster Emergency for the entire State of New York; and

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus which causes coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") spreads readily from person-to-person; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends wearing cloth face coverings which cover the nose and mouth in order to slow the spread of the novel coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, The CDC has made this recommendation as an additional public health measure people should take to reduce the spread of novel coronavirus in addition to, not instead of, social distancing, frequent hand cleaning and other everyday preventive actions; and WHEREAS, Erie County Government must continue to operate and provide essential services to the residents of Erie County in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, continuation of governmental functions and the ability to provide essential services is dependent on maintaining a healthy workforce.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mark C. Poloncarz, the Chief Executive of the County of Erie, New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 24(1) of New York State Executive Law do hereby:

• ORDER that all Erie County employees, fee-for-service workers, contractors, interns and volunteers, who are able to medically tolerate a face-covering, must cover their nose and mouth with a mask or cloth face-covering when present in any building or facility owned or operated by Erie County whenever they are unable to maintain, or when not maintaining, social distance.

This order shall take effect at 10:46 kM, on 15, 2020 and shall remain in effect for five days or until removed by order of the Chief Executive. This order may also be renewed in five (5) day increments.

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2020 and May 25, 2020, I extended such local emergency order for a respective period of five days; and

WHEREAS, the County of Erie and the State of New York remain in a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) continues to recommend wearing cloth face coverings which cover the nose and mouth in order to slow the spread of the novel coronavirus.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mark C. Poloncarz, the Chief Executive of the County of Erie, New York, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 24(2) of New York State Executive Law do hereby:

• Extend the local emergency order issued under my hand on May 15, 2020.

This local emergency order extension shall take effect at 10:00 am on May 30, 2020 and shall remain in effect for five days or until removed by order of the Chief Executive. The local emergency order may continue to be renewed in five (5) day increments.
