***Honoring Erin Sullivan for All-Star selection***

WHEREAS, the Erie County Legislature seeks to honor individuals and institutions of Erie County who enhance the quality of life in the community through their efforts; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** has been awarded her second berth on the Ontario Intercollegiate Women's Fast-pitch Association all-star team; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** is a 2018 graduate of East Aurora High School and began playing fast-pitch softball as a member of the East Aurora baseball and softball program at the age of twelve; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** attends the University of Toronto and has shined on the field for the school's softball team; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** finished the 2021 season with a .405 batting average, an on-base percentage of .500 and a slugging percentage of .429; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** is a dominant pitcher as well, as she posted a 1.89 earned run average and an outstanding 1.11 WHIP (walks plus hits allowed divided by innings pitched); and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** will be traveling to Tel Aviv, Israel this summer to play for Team Canada in the Maccabi Games, which includes 10,000 athletes from 50 countries to compete in 45 sports; and

WHEREAS, **Erin Sullivan** will graduate spring 2022 with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology and will pursue her master's degree as she continues playing softball for the Varsity Blues; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Erie County Legislature pauses in its deliberations to honor **Erin Sullivan** for earning her second all-star team selection and wishes her continued success in her academic and athletic pursuits.
