Attention Akron-Newstead Residents:

Effective January 1, 2019 there will be a **major change** in the policies and procedures for the Town of Newstead annual **Tire Drop-off Event**.

1. All old tire permit cards have expired and are no longer valid.
2. The new policy and procedures for the tire drop-off are:
 - a. You must provide a valid driver's license and/or proof of Akron-Newstead residency at the drop-off event
 - b. You must provide the attached signed statement at the event and pre-pay any new "over the limit" fees at the Newstead Town Hall, 5 Clarence Center Rd, Akron, NY prior to the event and provide a receipt of payment of those fees at the event.
 - c. The **first 8 regular sized tires** up to 20" are **free** including golf cart tires, ATV & riding lawn mower tires.
 - d. **Every tire after the first 8 will incur a fee of \$2.00 per tire, with a maximum limit of 8 additional tires (16 total per address, No longer per parcel)**
 - e. **Oversized tires will be accepted at the following costs:**
 - **20.5"-22.5" tires- \$10.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - **23"-24.5" tires- \$13.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - **25"-26.5" tires- \$16.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - **27"-28.5" tires- \$19.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - **29"-30.5" tires- \$21.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - **All tractor tires- \$25.00 per tire with a limit of 4 total**
 - f. Anyone caught dumping tires on roads within the town limits will be subject to fines as set forth in the Town Code.
