

2018 Erie County Seniors of the Year

Nomination Form

The Department of Senior Services is seeking nominees for *Erie County Senior of the Year*, a resident over the age of 60 whose community involvement has made a difference to others---improving the quality of life in and around Erie County---*and* having put to use his or her knowledge, skills, values and motivation to enable that difference.

Nominations must include the following:

- 1) A brief biography. How long the nominee has lived in Erie County, where she/he currently resides, dates of military service and military branch, past/present careers, hobbies, neighborhood/family details of interest (number of children, grandchildren, great grandchildren). Approximately 100 words.
- 2) A list of the organizations in Erie County where the nominee volunteers, or has volunteered. Include approximate dates.
- 3) A description of the nominee's contributions to the community through civic engagement. Be sure to include dates of each volunteer service, current and ongoing volunteer activity, any ventures the nominee developed and coordinated over time, and any community recognition. Consideration of lifetime achievement/recognition may be incorporated if it is linked with volunteer service after the age of sixty. Approximately 125 words.
